CHAPTER 27. CONSTABLES

§ 2703 Qualification and training.

- (a) A constable must be 21 years of age or older.
- (b) To be approved by the Board of Examiners, a constable applicant shall meet the minimum standards established by the Board and shall participate in such other training as the Board requires.
- (c) The Board of Examiners may require commissioned constables to receive such additional training or education as it deems necessary.

RULES & REGULATIONS

8.0 Canine

8.1 In order for a constable to use a canine, he/she, and the canine, must complete a training program approved by the Board and all certifications or re-certifications must be on file with the Professional Licensing Section.
