CHAPTER 27. CONSTABLES

§ 2703 Qualification and training.

- (a) A constable must be 21 years of age or older.
- (b) To be approved by the Board of Examiners, a constable applicant shall meet the minimum standards established by the Board and shall participate in such other training as the Board requires.
- (c) The Board of Examiners may require commissioned constables to receive such additional training or education as it deems necessary.

RULES & REGULATIONS

6.0 Baton, Nightstick, Pr24, Chemical Spray, and Handcuffs

6.1 To carry the above weapons/items a constable must have completed a training program on each and every weapon/item carried and all certifications must be on file in the Professional Licensing Section to be valid to carry/use. Under no circumstances would a person be permitted to carry any other type weapon/item, unless first approved by the Professional Licensing Section.
