

****Update** Troopers Investigating Fatal Hit and Run Crash with Bicyclist-Dover**

Dover– The Delaware State Police Collision Reconstruction Unit is seeking the public's assistance in identifying the vehicle involved in the May 4th hit and run fatal crash with a bicyclist.

Investigators are searching for a 2002-2003 GMC Envoy, possibly maroon in color, with damage to the front grill or hood area, and lower bumper (no further description available).
