

# Troopers Investigating Late Reported Shots Fired Incident-Bridgeville

***Bridgeville, Delaware*** – The Delaware State Police are currently investigating an incident in which shots were fired at a residence last night.

The preliminary investigation has determined shots were fired in the unit block of Mill Park Drive, Bridgeville at approximately 8:30 p.m., Saturday, January 19, 2019. The occupants of the residence called the following day and reported hearing a fight outside just before shots being fired. The 33-year-old female and 37-year-old-male occupants discovered damage to the their residence from the apparent shots fired. There were no reports of injury as a result of this incident.

There is no suspect information at this time.
