

Troopers Investigating Robbery and Theft of Motor Vehicle- Bear

Bear- The Delaware State Police are investigating a robbery and theft of a motor vehicle that occurred yesterday morning.

The incident occurred on April 20, 2020 at approximately 9:53 a.m., at Lowes located at 1030 East Songsmith Drive, Bear. Troopers made contact with the 21-year-old female victim who advised she parked her vehicle in the southwest area of the Lowes parking lot and was walking inside the store. The victim indicated as she entered the store, she was approached from behind by an unknown suspect. The suspect snatched the victim's vehicle keys, which she was holding in her hand, and fled on foot. The suspect located the victim's vehicle in the parking lot and fled the area in an unknown direction. The victim did not sustain injury as a result of this incident.

The suspect was described as a white male, approximately 30 years old, approximately 6'4", and wearing dark colored clothing.
