

Troopers Attempting to Identify Burglary Suspect-Dover



Dover– The Delaware State Police are attempting to identify the suspect involved in a burglary, which occurred at Subway sandwich shop located at 1151 East Lebanon Road (SR 10) Unit A, Dover.

On June 6, 2020, at approximately 4:48 a.m., an unknown suspect broke into the business. Once inside, the suspect

removed an undisclosed amount of money before fleeing through the rear parking lot of the business on a bicycle.

The suspect is described to be a white or light skinned black male wearing a dark-colored jacket and pants, light colored beanie and dark sneakers with white soles. He also was carrying a black backpack with a red marking on top.
