

Troopers Attempting to Identify Robbery Suspect- Lewes



Lewes- The Delaware State Police are investigating a strong-armed robbery that occurred Saturday, June 13, 2020, at approximately 2:00 p.m. at Weis grocery store located at 17232 North Village Main Blvd., Lewes.

During the incident, the female suspect followed the 65-year-old male victim from Lewes, DE, out of the grocery store to his vehicle. Once there, the suspect and victim had a brief struggle as the suspect stole the wallet out of the victim's hands. The suspect then fled on foot, possibly to a nearby parking lot. The victim sustained minor injuries as a result of the incident but was not transported to the hospital for treatment. No weapon was displayed or implied.

The suspect is a white or Hispanic female, approximately 20 years old, 5'00"- 5'5", black hair, wearing a white t-shirt, dark-colored shorts, tall black socks, brown shoes, and carrying a black Nike drawstring backpack with white lettering. The suspect possibly fled the scene in a red-colored sedan with unknown registration.
