

***UPDATE- ATTEMPT TO LOCATE SUSPECT* WANTED FOR ROBBERY OF DOLLAR GENERAL- WILMINGTON**

Wilmington- The Delaware State Police are seeking the public's assistance with locating **Ahmed E. Muhammad**. Muhammad is wanted in connection to an armed robbery that occurred at the Dollar General located at 2605 Philadelphia Pike, Wilmington, on June 9, 2020, at 8:49 p.m.

During the incident, Muhammad entered the store and remained in the business after closing. When asked to leave by an employee, he displayed a handgun and demanded money. The employee complied with the demand and turned over an undisclosed amount of cash. The employee was not injured as a result of the incident.
