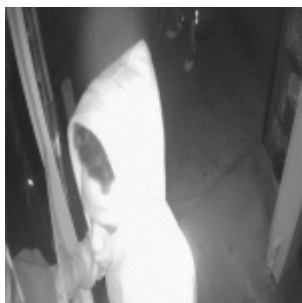
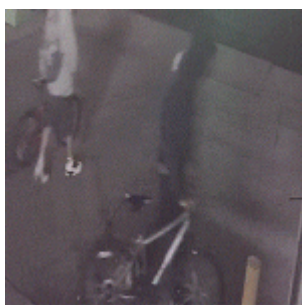
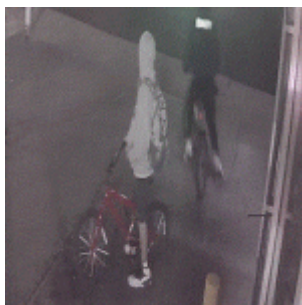


# Public's Assistance Requested Identifying Burglary Suspects - Seaford





**Seaford, DE-** Delaware State Police are seeking the public's assistance identifying two suspects wanted in connection to a Seaford convenience store burglary.

On June 28, 2021, at approximately 6:00 a.m., Delaware State Police responded to Tru Blu convenience store located at 1611 Middleford Road, Seaford, for a reported burglary. The investigation determined during the overnight hours, two male suspects forced entry into the business and removed an undisclosed amount of goods.

The first suspect is described as a male with curly hair. He was wearing a hooded sweatshirt with "NAVY" written on the back, gloves, and sweatpants.

The second suspect is described as a male with a goatee and glasses. He was wearing shorts and a Ravens hooded sweatshirt that says, "Win, lose or tie. I'm a Raven's fan until I die".

He was also carrying a book bag.
