

Delaware State Police Investigating Convenience Store Robbery- Wilmington

Wilmington– Delaware State Police are investigating the robbery of a Wilmington area convenience store that occurred early this morning.

The incident occurred at approximately 1:55 a.m., Friday, October 8, 2021, at the Dash In convenience store, located at 4598 Kirkwood Highway, Wilmington, when troopers responded for a report of a robbery. Investigation determined a male suspect entered the store and confronted a female employee behind the sales counter. The suspect implied he had a gun and advised the employee this is a robbery. The suspect demanded cigarettes and removed several packs from the shelf. Once obtaining numerous packs of cigarettes, the suspect fled the scene on foot southbound Limestone Road. The employee was not injured as a result of the incident.

The suspect was described as a black male approximately 30 years of age wearing all dark clothing.

No surveillance images are available at this time.
