

Troopers Arrest Man for 6th Offense DUI

Delaware State Police have arrested 58-year-old **Robert Cooper** of Laurel, Delaware for felony DUI following an investigation that occurred yesterday afternoon.

On October 23, 2022, at approximately 12:17 p.m., troopers responded to the parking lot of the Nylon Capital Shopping Center, located at 1023 West Stein Highway in Seaford, regarding a subject who had been reportedly drinking and driving. Troopers located a red 2014 Chevrolet Cruze in the parking lot, which was occupied by Robert Cooper. A DUI investigation ensued after troopers contacted Cooper and noticed signs of impairment. Cooper was subsequently taken into custody at the scene without incident. Computer checks of Cooper showed that he had five prior convictions for DUI.

Cooper was transported to the nearby Seaford Police Department, where he was charged with Sixth Offense DUI. Cooper was arraigned by Justice of the Peace Court # 3 and committed to Sussex Correctional Institution on \$50,000 cash bond.
