- **Designate a sober driver, call a sober friend, call a sober family member, or use a rideshare service**
- **If you spot a drunk or aggressive driver on the road, contact 911 immediately**
- **If someone you know is about to drive while impaired, take their keys and help them find a safe way home**
- **Eliminate driving distractions such as texting**
- **Be aware of increased pedestrian and bicycle traffic by yielding to**

pedestrians and sharing the road responsibly
