

State Police Asking for Public's Help Locating Suspect Vehicles in Fatal Pedestrian Hit-and-Run Crash

The Delaware State Police continues to investigate the [fatal pedestrian hit-and-run crash](#) that occurred on Harbeson Road last week. Troopers are asking for the public's help in locating two vehicles involved in the crash.

The Delaware State Police Troop 7 Collision Reconstruction Unit is attempting to locate the two vehicles involved in the [fatal pedestrian hit-and-run crash](#) that occurred on April 19, 2024. The first vehicle is described as a silver car with moderate front-end damage. The second vehicle is described as a smaller white SUV with minor front-end damage or damage to the undercarriage. Both vehicles were last seen driving northbound on Harbeson Road after the crash.
