

State Police Detectives Investigating Robbery of a Pizza Delivery Driver in Seaford

The Delaware State Police are investigating an armed robbery of a pizza delivery driver in Seaford on Friday night.

On May 10, 2024, at approximately 10:39 p.m., troopers responded to a report of an armed robbery that occurred on the 24000 block of German Road in Seaford. During the preliminary investigation, detectives learned that three unknown male suspects approached the victim while he was making a delivery at a house. One of the suspects pointed a gun at the victim, took the pizza, and stole his Toyota Camry. The victim was not hurt.

On May 11, 2024, at approximately 1:30 a.m., troopers saw the stolen Camry and pulled it over. When they pulled it over, the occupants ran, but the driver, identified as 18-year-old **Asjmeir Fiorentino** of Seaford, was caught a short time later. Troopers searched for the other occupants but did not find them.

Fiorentino was taken to Troop 5, charged with the crimes listed below, arraigned by Justice of the Peace Court 7, and released on his own recognizance.



- Receiving Stolen Property over \$1,500 (Felony)
- Resisting Arrest
- Driving Without a License
- Failure to Signal
