

***Update – Victim and Suspect Identified* State Police Detectives Investigating Homicide and Officer-Involved Shooting in Dover**

Delaware State Police have identified 59-year-old **William Whitehead** of Frederica, Delaware, as the [victim of a homicide that occurred on June 4, 2024, in Dover](#). The murder suspect, identified as 51-year-old **Arnold Azamar** of Camden, Delaware, died in the officer-involved shooting that occurred following the homicide.

Per Delaware State Police standard operating procedures, the troopers involved have been placed on administrative leave while a use-of-force investigation is conducted in conjunction with the Delaware Department of Justice.
