

Troop 2 Collision Reconstruction Unit Investigating Fatal Two- Vehicle Crash in Newark

The Delaware State Police continues to investigate a Newark area crash that occurred Saturday afternoon after 91-year-old **William Blevins** of Newark, Delaware, died from injuries sustained in the crash.

On May 10, 2025, at approximately 4:31 p.m., a gray 2013 RAM 150 was traveling southbound on Sunset Lake Road, north of Broadleaf Drive in Newark. The preliminary investigation indicates that at the same time, a brown 2017 Honda Accord was possibly traveling southbound on Sunset Lake Road, in front of the RAM. For reasons under investigation, the Honda allegedly attempted to make a wide U-turn towards the northbound lane of Sunset Lake Road. As a result, the Honda entered the RAM's path of travel as it was making the left turn, and the 2 vehicles collided.

The driver of the Honda, identified as William Blevins, was taken to an area hospital for serious injuries. **On May 12, 2025**, Blevins died from injuries sustained in the crash. His family and relatives were notified.

The driver of the RAM, a 60-year-old man from Bear, Delaware, was not injured.
