

State Police Detectives Investigating Shooting in Lewes

Delaware State Police are investigating a shooting that occurred last week in Lewes.

On July 7, 2025, troopers responded to the 29000 block of Frenchman Bay Drive in Lewes for a late reported shooting. When troopers arrived, they learned that on July 3, 2025, at approximately 10:30 p.m., an unknown suspect fired an unknown number of shots that hit an occupied house. Two adults were inside at the time, and no one was injured. The incident remains under investigation.

Delaware State Police Troop 4 Criminal Investigations Unit continues to investigate this incident.
