

State Police Investigating Homicide in Milton; Asking for the Public's Help Locating Suspect

The Delaware State Police are investigating a homicide that occurred yesterday on Forest Road in Milton, and detectives are asking for the public's help locating the suspect, 62-year-old **Myron Savage**, from Milton, Delaware.

On April 11, 2026, at approximately 5:30 p.m., troopers responded to the 20000 block of Forest Road in Milton for a report of a shooting. When troopers arrived, they found a 47-year-old man suffering from gunshot wounds, and he was pronounced dead at the scene.

Due to the nature of the incident, the Delaware State Police Homicide Unit assumed the investigation. The preliminary investigation revealed that the suspect, Myron Savage, approached the victim in the front yard of a residence on foot, shot him several times, then fled the area on an unknown type, black 3-wheeled scooter. Detectives obtained a warrant for Savage's arrest and are working to locate him.

Anyone with information as to the whereabouts of **Myron Savage** are asked to call 9-1-1.
