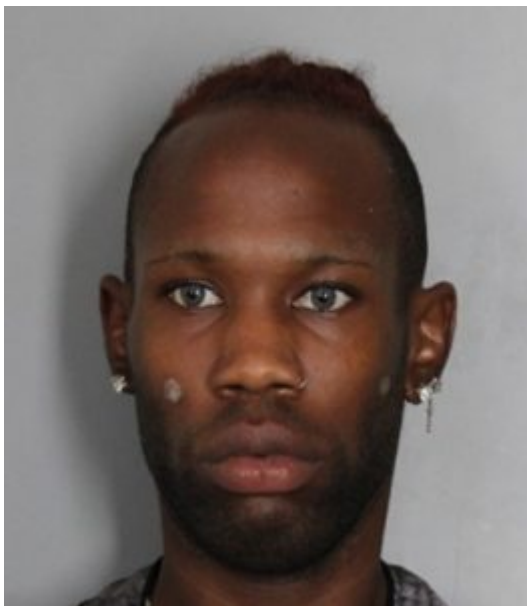


***Update – Robbery Suspect Arrested * State Police Investigating WSFS Bank Robbery in Rehoboth Beach**

The Delaware State Police have arrested 26-year-old **Demetrius Frith-Thompson**, of Milford, Delaware, for the [bank robbery](#) that occurred at WSFS Bank in Rehoboth Beach.

On September 3, 2026, [Frith-Thompson](#) turned himself in at Troop 4. He was charged with the crimes listed below, arraigned by the Justice of the Peace, and released on a \$3,000 unsecured bond.



- Robbery 2nd Degree (Felony)
- Wearing a Disguise During the Commission of a Felony (Felony)

The Delaware State Police Troop 4 Criminal Investigations Unit continues to investigate this incident.
