

Update – Suspect Arrested

State Police Seek Public's Assistance Locating Suspect in Wilmington Robbery

The Delaware State Police arrested 32-year-old **Diamond Betsill**, of Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, who was wanted in connection with a robbery that occurred earlier this month at a Wawa in Wilmington.

On September 5, 2026, at approximately 8:30 p.m., troopers responded to the Wawa located at 1702 Rocky Run Parkway in Wilmington for a report of a stolen vehicle. The preliminary investigation determined the victim and Betsill arrived at the Wawa together in the victim's vehicle. Shortly afterward, the two became involved in a verbal confrontation that turned physical. During the dispute, Betsill used force to overpower the victim and stole the vehicle.

The victim was not injured during the incident.

Through an investigation, troopers identified Betsill as the suspect and obtained a warrant for her arrest.

On September 15, 2026, Betsill was arrested and charged with a felony offense of robbery second degree. She was arraigned by the Justice of the Peace Court before being released on a \$10,000 unsecured bond.
