Renewals/Continuing Education

Renewal process for Bail Enforcement Agents:

- Must Complete the BEA application that can be obtained at the below link.
- Follow the directions for the fingerprinting process at either SBI Dover or Troop 2.
- A non-refundable processing fee of \$65.00 is due at the time of fingerprinting. Fee can be paid by cash,

certified check, Visa, Master Card, Discover, company check, or money order. No personal checks accepted.

- NOTE: Upon approval, an email will be sent with instructions on how to obtain your renewed identification card and license.
- The four year renewal fee of \$50.00 shall be paid at this time.
