## **Renewals/Continuing Education**

Renewal process for Bail Enforcement Agents:

- Individuals must call Professional Licensing (302)-739-5991 for an appointment and come into one of our two (2) Professional Licensing locations (DSP Troop 2/Newark or Dover-SBI Office) for fingerprint and

picture processing. Address locations are listed below.

- Individuals must complete the employee application, see the link below. Applications are also available at both Professional Licensing locations (DSP Troop2/Newark or Dover-SBI Office).
- A non-refundable processing fee of \$65.00 is due at the time of fingerprinting. Fee can be paid by cash, certified check, Visa, Master Card, Discover, company check, or money order. No personal checks accepted.
- Upon approval, an email will be sent with instructions on how to obtain your renewed identification card and license. The four-year renewal fee of \$50.00 will be due upon receipt.
