REMINDER

The Firearms 40 hour course covers ONLY a day and low light shoot. Another day shoot must be done within the calendar year – 90 days later. To remain qualified, firearms qualifications must be done three times per calendar year, with the two day shoots at least 90 days apart. The low light shoot may be combined with one of the day shoots.

- Please submit current proof of certification by the National Rifle Association as a NRA LE instructor, a law enforcement training and standards commission (i.e. C.O.P.T.), and/or another professional firearms training institution as a “certified law enforcement firearms instructor”. All certifications must have an expiration date listed.

Private Security Guard Training

To become an approved mandatory security guard instructor you must pass the Train the Trainer course taught by Delaware Technical Community College. You must be employed by a Delaware State Police licensed Security Guard Agency and you must present written approval from the agency to train their employees. You can only train individuals for the agencies that employ you as per the Administrative Code, Title 24, Section 4.0.
