Investigating Shooting at Unsanctioned Car Meet in Newark

Delaware State Police are investigating a shooting that occurred at an unsanctioned car meet in the area of Tyler Way in Newark early this morning that left one man injured.

On August 18, 2024, at approximately 1:21 a.m., troopers responded to Tyler Way, north of Dawson Drive, in Newark, for a report of a shooting. Upon arriving, troopers found a 17-year-old male suffering from multiple gunshot wounds to his legs. The victim was transported to a nearby hospital, where he was treated and released.

The preliminary investigation revealed that a large crowd gathered for an unsanctioned car meet on Tyler Way. At some point during the event, the victim was involved in a confrontation with a male suspect, who threatened to shoot him during the argument. A short time later, a second male suspect approached the victim and shot the victim with a handgun. After the shooting, the two suspects fled in a silver sedan in an unknown direction.

The first suspect is described as a Middle Eastern male wearing a white hooded sweatshirt. The second suspect/shooter is described as a light-skinned black male with dreadlocks wearing a black hooded sweatshirt and a mask covering his face. There is no additional description available for the suspect vehicle. Surveillance video and images are not yet available.

State Police Investigating Two-Vehicle Fatal Crash in Middletown

The Delaware State Police are investigating a two-vehicle fatal crash that occurred early this morning in Middletown that left one man and one woman dead.

On August 18, 2024, at approximately 12:30 a.m., a blue 2022 Honda Civic was traveling in the left southbound lane of Dupont Parkway, approaching the intersection with Harris Road. At the same time, a black 2015 Jeep Wrangler was traveling northbound in the southbound lanes of Dupont Parkway, in the Honda's path of travel. As a result, the front of the Jeep struck the front of the Honda in the left southbound lane of Dupont Parkway, north of Harris Road.

The driver of the Honda, a 62-year-old man, and the Honda's passenger, a 51-year-old woman, both from Smyrna, Delaware,

were pronounced dead at the scene. Their names are being withheld until their family and relatives are notified.

The driver of the Jeep, a 28-year-old woman from Massey, Maryland, was taken by ambulance to an area hospital for critical injuries.

The roadway was closed for approximately 4 hours while the scene was investigated and cleared.

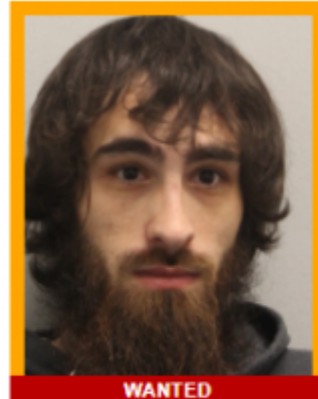

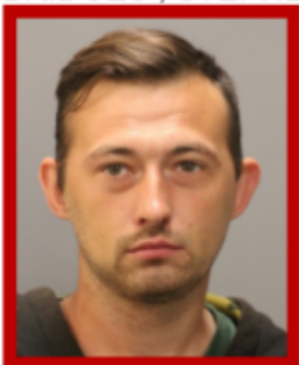

State Police Detectives Investigating Shooting in New Castle

Delaware State Police are investigating a shooting in New Castle today that left a teenager injured.

On August 16, 2024, at approximately 12:20 a.m., troopers responded to a shooting at the McDonald's located at 101 South

Dupont Highway in New Castle. The investigation revealed that a car was traveling westbound on Christiana Road, approaching Pleasant Place, when it made a U-turn at the intersection. As the car completed the turn, the occupants noticed two unknown black males wearing dark clothing at the intersection, one of whom fired several shots at the vehicle. The passenger, a 16-year-old, was struck in the thigh. The victims then drove to McDonald's and called 9-1-1. The injured teen was transported to a local hospital with non-life-threatening injuries, while the driver, a 51-year-old man, was unharmed.

State Police Investigating Fatal Bicycle Crash in

Seaford

The Delaware State Police are investigating a fatal crash involving a 3-year-old bicyclist in Seaford.

On August 15, 2024, at approximately 7:45 p.m., a Toyota Tacoma was traveling westbound on a gravel road between North Parkway Road and South Parkway Road in the community of Mobile Gardens. At the same time, a 3-year-old child was riding a bicycle in the middle of North Parkway Road. The preliminary investigation revealed that the Tacoma turned southbound on North Parkway Road, and the front of the Tacoma hit the child.

The 3-year-old child from Seaford, Delaware, was taken to an area hospital by family members where they died. Their name is being withheld until their family is notified. The driver of the Tacoma, a 56-year-old woman from Seaford, Delaware, was not injured.

North Parkway Road was closed for approximately 4 hours while the scene was investigated and cleared.

Delaware State Police are investigating a hit-and-run crash that claimed the life of a man early this morning.

On August 16, 2024, at approximately 1:40 a.m., an unknown vehicle was driving northbound on South Dupont Highway, just south of POW/MIA Parkway. At the same time, a pedestrian was near or on the northbound shoulder of South Dupont Highway, south of POW/MIA Parkway. The investigation revealed that the vehicle struck the pedestrian and fled the scene in an unknown direction.

The victim, a 62-year-old man from Dover, was pronounced dead at the scene. His name is being withheld until his family has been notified.

South Dupont Highway was closed for approximately 3 hours while the scene was investigated and cleared.

Delaware State Police Ask for Public's Help in Death Investigation

Delaware State Police are investigating the death of 67-year-old **Nathaniel Prenters** of Magnolia, Delaware, and are asking for the public's help.

On August 14, 2024, at approximately 4:18 p.m., Mr. Prenters was found dead at the Recycling Management Center located at 100 Amer Rd in Wilmington, Delaware. Troopers responded to the recycling center after employees found him in a processing area. It is important to note that Mr. Prenters was not an employee of the recycling center. The cause of death remains unknown, and autopsy results are pending.

Mr. Prenters was last seen at approximately 6:45 a.m. on Sunday, August 11, at a residence on Juanita Drive in Magnolia, Delaware. His activities and whereabouts between that time and the discovery of his body are currently unknown.
