

Delaware State Police Investigating Shooting in Milton

Delaware State Police are investigating a shooting that occurred in Milton this morning.

On July 22, 2024, at approximately 4:47 a.m., troopers responded to the 14000 block of Collins Street in Milton for a report of a shooting. When troopers arrived, they found a 19-year-old man that had been shot in the upper torso and began life-saving efforts. The victim was taken by ambulance to an area hospital with life-threatening injuries. The preliminary investigation revealed that the victim was living in a shed on the property when an unknown suspect fired several shots into the shed, hitting the victim.

The Homicide Unit is actively investigating this incident. Detectives are asking anyone with information regarding this case to contact Detective A. Bluto by calling (302) 741-2859. State Police Investigate Late-Night Shooting on New Castle Avenue

The Delaware State Police are investigating a shooting incident that occurred late Saturday night on New Castle Avenue in New Castle, Delaware.

On July 20, 2024, at approximately 10:53 p.m., troopers responded to a report of a shooting in the 3100 block of New Castle Avenue. Preliminary investigations revealed that an 18-year-old man and a 17-year-old male, both from Wilmington, Delaware, were riding their bicycles northbound on New Castle Avenue. As they approached the Spice N' Nice Restaurant, they crossed from the east side of the roadway to the west side.

During this crossing, the 18-year-old man felt a sudden impact and realized he had been shot. As the shooting continued, he managed to cross back to the east side of the road and then started running after abandoning his bicycle. Meanwhile, the 17-year-old male continued riding northbound on New Castle Avenue. The unidentified suspect(s) fled the scene.

The 18-year-old victim was transported to a nearby hospital with non-life-threatening gunshot wounds. No other injuries were reported.

Currently, there is no description of the suspect(s), and no video surveillance or images are available.

Delaware State Police Troop 2 Criminal Investigations Unit continues its investigation and believes the incident occurred between 10:30 p.m. and 11:00 p.m. Troopers are seeking assistance from the public and urge anyone with exterior home surveillance in the area or who may have witnessed the incident to contact Detective J. Delaware State Police Investigate Attempted Robbery Leading to Crash

Delaware State Police are investigating an attempted robbery that resulted in a vehicle crash on Friday night.

On July 19, 2024, at approximately 8:30 p.m., troopers were dispatched to Railroad Avenue in Townsend for a reported robbery. The preliminary investigation revealed that two young victims, a 19-year-old man from Middletown, Delaware, and an 18-year-old woman from Newark, Delaware, had arranged to sell vape pens to an unknown individual they had met through social media.

When they arrived at a residence on the 500 block of Railroad Avenue, the victims were approached by two suspects on foot. The suspects entered the vehicle, brandished handguns, and demanded the vape pens and money.

In response, the 19-year-old driver began honking the vehicle's horn, causing one suspect to flee. The second suspect remained inside as the driver attempted to escape by driving away. The vehicle veered off Railroad Avenue and collided with a utility pole before crashing into a nearby residence. After the crash, all individuals exited the vehicle. The 19-year-old driver pursued the suspects, at which point one of the suspects fired a shot at him. The suspects then fled the scene.

The 18-year-old woman was taken to a nearby hospital for minor injuries sustained during the crash. No other injuries were reported, including from the occupied residence that was struck. Currently, there is no description of the suspects, and no video surveillance or images are available at this time.

Investigating Fatal Two-Vehicle Crash in Bridgeville

The Delaware State Police continues to investigate a Bridgeville area crash that occurred early Wednesday morning after 22-year-old **Djifenson Dorilus** of Salisbury, Maryland, died from injuries sustained in the crash.

On July 17, 2024, at approximately 12:59 a.m., a 2017 Dodge Durango was traveling in a northbound lane of Sussex Highway, approaching the area of Newtown Road. Simultaneously, a 2013 Hyundai Santa Fe was traveling southbound in a northbound lane of Sussex Highway, in the Dodge's path of travel. Both vehicles were traveling in the left northbound lane of Sussex Highway as they approached each other from opposite directions. In an attempt to avoid a collision with the Hyundai, the Dodge moved into the right northbound lane of Sussex Highway. At the same time, the Hyundai also moved into the right northbound lane of Sussex Highway. As a result, the front of the Hyundai struck the front of the Dodge. After the initial impact, the Hyundai overturned onto its roof and rotated clockwise before it came to rest between the shoulder and the right northbound lane. The Dodge rotated clockwise and came to rest on the centerline of the roadway.

The driver of the Hyundai, identified as Djifenson Dorilus, was transported to an area hospital for life-threatening injuries. **On July 18, 2024**, Djifenson died from injuries sustained in the crash. His family and relatives were notified.

The driver of the Dodge, a 46-year-old man from Millsboro, Delaware, was taken to an area hospital for a serious injury.

The roadway was closed for approximately 3 hours while the scene was investigated and cleared.

Detectives Investigating Wilmington Area WSFS Bank Robbery

The Delaware State Police are investigating a bank robbery that occurred yesterday afternoon at the WSFS Bank in Wilmington.

On July 16, 2024, at approximately 2:51 p.m., troopers responded to the WSFS Bank, located at 4601 Kirkwood Highway, Wilmington, for a report of a robbery. The preliminary investigation revealed an unknown white male suspect entered the bank and presented a demand note to the bank teller. The victim complied and the suspect fled on foot with an undisclosed amount of cash. Troopers attempted to locate the suspect in the surrounding area but were unable to find him.

The suspect is described as an unknown white male wearing a black mask. Surveillance images and video are not yet available.

State Police Investigating Fatal Crash in Lewes

Delaware State Police are investigating a fatal crash that occurred in Lewes last night.

On July 15, 2024, at approximately 11:26 p.m., a BMW 328 was driving eastbound near the 16000 block of Gills Neck Road at an apparent high rate of speed. For reasons under investigation, the BMW left the road as it approached a sharp curve on Gills Neck Road. The BMW then continued onto a residential property, where it struck a wall/pillar, a tree, and a metal fence. After striking the tree, the BMW became

engulfed in fire. The fire spread to the house causing extensive damage. The occupants of the house exited and were not injured.

The driver and passenger were pronounced dead at the scene. Their names are being withheld until their family is notified.

The roadway was closed for approximately three hours while the scene was investigated and cleared.

State Police Investigating Shooting Near Milton, Detectives Ask for Help Finding Suspect

Delaware State Police are investigating a shooting that occurred near Milton last night.

On July 14, 2024, at approximately 7:49 p.m., troopers responded to Cool Spring Road near Fisher Road, for a Ford Explorer that crashed into a utility pole. When troopers arrived, they learned that the driver, a 27-year-old man from Laurel, Delaware, had been shot in the back. He was taken to an area hospital with critical injuries. The preliminary

investigation revealed that the victim was driving on West Springside Drive when the suspect fired several rounds at the Explorer, hitting the victim. After the shooting, the Explorer drove away and hit a utility pole a short distance away.

Through investigative means, detectives identified the suspect responsible for the shooting as 24-year-old **Timmarus Perry** of Milton, Delaware. Detectives have obtained a warrant for Perry's arrest for the shooting.
