

State Police Investigating Two Robberies at Wilmington Casino

The Delaware State Police is investigating two robberies that occurred Sunday night at a Wilmington Casino.

On March 8, 2026, at approximately 10:30 p.m., troopers responded to the Delaware Park Casino, located at 777 Delaware Park Boulevard in Wilmington, for two reported robberies. The preliminary investigation revealed two victims were walking through the parking lot when two unknown suspects exited a dark-colored Nissan sedan while armed with handguns. The suspects demanded the victims' property, and the victims complied. The suspects then fled the area in the Nissan with an undisclosed amount of money and the victims' personal property.

Investigators learned the suspects returned to the parking lot a short time later and approached another person walking through the lot. The suspects again displayed handguns and demanded the victim's property. During the robbery, one of the suspects struck the victim in the head with a handgun before stealing the victim's car keys. The suspects then fled the area in both the Nissan and the victim's vehicle. The victim who was struck with the handgun, a 24-year-old man from Avondale, Pennsylvania, was taken to a local hospital with non-life-threatening injuries.

Troopers and Officers from the New Castle County Police Department later located the victim's vehicle in the city limits of Wilmington. After a brief vehicle pursuit, the driver abandoned the vehicle and ran away in the area of Bradford Street and B Street, and was not apprehended.

The Delaware State Police Criminal Investigations Unit

State Police Arrest Dover Man for Robbery

The Delaware State Police have arrested 19-year-old **Malik Woodall**, from Dover, Delaware, following a robbery that occurred yesterday at Redner's in Dover.

On March 8, 2026, at approximately 5:40 p.m., troopers responded to Redner's, located at 88 Salt Creek Drive in Dover, for a report of a carjacking. When troopers arrived, they spoke to the 20-year-old male victim and learned that a black male suspect, wearing black clothes and a mask, approached him while he was sitting in his car and asked to use his phone. As the victim was handing the suspect the phone, he punched the victim and tried to prevent him from getting out of his car. When the victim got out of the car, the two began to fight. The suspect took the victim's phone and car after the victim ran inside the store for help. The

victim suffered minor injuries.

A witness to the incident followed the suspect, in the victim's car, to a residence on New Street in Dover. Troopers arrived a short time later and took the suspect, identified as Malik Woodall, into custody without incident.

Woodall was taken to Troop 3, where he was charged with the crimes listed below, arraigned by Justice of the Peace Court 7, and released on a \$1,000 unsecured bond.

- Robbery 2nd Degree – Prevent/Overcome Resistance, and Take Possession of Motor Vehicle (Felony)
- Assault 3rd Degree

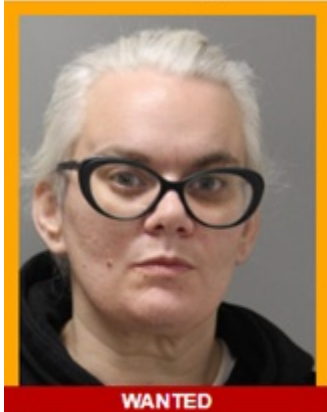

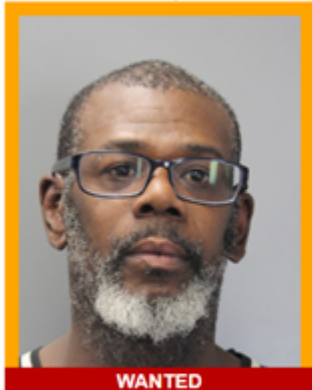

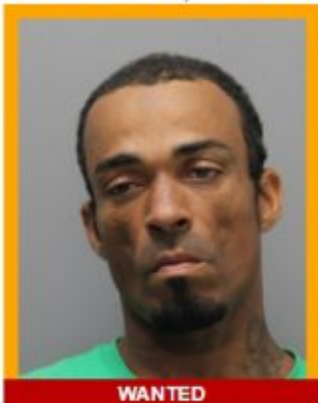

State Police Investigating Fatal E-Bike Crash in Dover

The Delaware State Police are investigating a fatal E-Bike crash that occurred on Monday in Dover.

On March 2, 2026, at approximately 1:45 p.m., a Chevrolet Cobalt was traveling northbound in the left lane on DuPont Highway (US 13) north of POW/MIA Parkway in Dover. At the same time, an Aniioki AQ-177 E-Bike entered the edge of the right lane of DuPont Highway from an unknown location. The preliminary investigation revealed that the E-Bike changed lanes and entered the Cobalt's path of travel. As a result, the Cobalt struck the E-Bike, ejecting the operator.

The operator of the E-Bike, 26-year-old **Jordan Schollenberger** of Camden, Delaware, was taken to a nearby hospital with life-threatening injuries. On March 3rd, he died from his injuries.

The driver of the Cobalt, a 19-year-old-woman from Harrington, Delaware, was not injured.

The [roadway was closed](#) for approximately three hours while the scene was investigated and cleared.

State Police Arrest Four Men for Burglary Spree in New Castle County

The Delaware State Police have made four arrests connected to a string of crimes in New Castle County in January. The suspects are 24-year-old **Damon Hancock** of Wilmington; 46-year-old **Elwood Hunter** of Smyrna; 34-year-old **Jerree Richardson** of Middletown; and 25-year-old **Malik Winters** of Claymont.

On January 7, 2026, troopers responded to the Four Points by Sheraton at 56 South Old Baltimore Pike in Newark for a report of a stolen vehicle. Troopers learned that at approximately 1:00 a.m., a Ford Transit van belonging to the hotel was stolen from the parking lot. During the following week, the four men used the stolen vehicle to commit two burglaries at reshipping companies on Quigley Boulevard and Bellcor Drive in New Castle. In both cases, the Ford Transit was driven through the garage doors into the businesses, where the four suspects then stole, in total, approximately \$169,000 in goods and caused approximately \$14,000 in damages. Detectives learned that the Newport Police Department was investigating a similar incident that occurred on January 9, 2026, within its town limits.

The Troop 2 Criminal Investigations Unit assumed the case and learned that a Honda sedan with Pennsylvania registration and a Chrysler minivan with Kentucky registration were also connected to the burglaries. A computer inquiry showed that the Chrysler was a rental and that it had been rented by Hunter. Additionally, on January 14, 2026, the stolen Ford Transit van was located in Chester, Pennsylvania, by the Delaware County Criminal Investigation Division (PA).

While detectives continued to investigate, on January 18,

2026, at approximately 12:40 a.m., troopers were dispatched to Carroll Drive in New Castle for a report of a burglary at another reshipping company. The owner reported that four suspects, using a white van, drove through the door, stole approximately \$1,000 in goods, and caused approximately \$5,000 in damages.

The suspects left the scene before troopers could arrive, but shortly thereafter, an officer from Newport Police Department spotted the involved Ford Econoline van, which had been reported stolen from Pennsylvania, in their jurisdiction and attempted to conduct a traffic stop. The van failed to stop, and a pursuit ensued, ending in the City of Wilmington where all four suspects ran from the vehicle. There, with the assistance of Newport and Wilmington Police Departments, Hancock and Richardson were taken into custody without incident.

Hancock was taken to Troop 2, where he was charged with the following offenses, arraigned by the Justice of the Peace Court 11, and committed to the Howard R. Young Correctional Institution on a \$67,000 cash bond.

Richardson was taken to Troop 2, where he was charged with the following offenses, arraigned by the Justice of the Peace Court 11, and committed to the Howard R. Young Correctional Institution on a \$75,000 cash bond.

Through further investigation, Hunter and Winters were identified as the remaining suspects, and a warrant was issued for their arrest.

On February 25, 2026, the Wilmington Police Department took Winters into custody for an unrelated matter, and he was charged with the following offenses, arraigned by the Justice of the Peace Court 11, and committed to the Howard R. Young Correctional Institution on a \$77,500 cash bond

Search Warrant in Dagsboro Leads to Arrest for Drug and Weapon Offenses

The Delaware State Police have arrested 48-year-old **Dominick Drummond** of Dagsboro, Delaware, for felony drug and weapons charges following a search warrant yesterday in Dagsboro.

On March 2, 2026, members of the, Sussex County Drug Unit, Sussex County Governor's Task Force and the Delaware State Police Special Operations Response Team, executed a search warrant at a property on the 27000 block of Dagsboro Road in Dagsboro. The search warrant was obtained following an investigation of Dominick Drummond for the distribution of illegal narcotics from the residence. During the search warrant, Drummond was seen discarding narcotics into a fire pit on the property. Drummond and three other people were detained without incident.

A search of the property led to the discovery of the following items:

- Approximately 122.02 grams of cocaine
- Approximately 38.6 grams of crack cocaine
- Stolen 9mm handgun
- Multiple rounds of 12-gauge ammunition
- Drug paraphernalia
- \$16,030 in suspected drug proceeds

Drummond was arrested and taken to Troop 4, where he was charged with the crimes listed below, arraigned by Justice of the Peace Court 2, and committed to Sussex Correctional Institution on a \$131,000 cash bond.



- Manufacture, Deliver, Possession with Intent to Deliver a Controlled Substance, Tier 3 (Felony) – 2 counts

Two of the three people detained were charged with misdemeanor offenses and released on their own recognizance.

The Delaware State Police arrested 42-year-old **Christopher Naylor**, of Dover, Delaware, for felony drug charges in Dover.

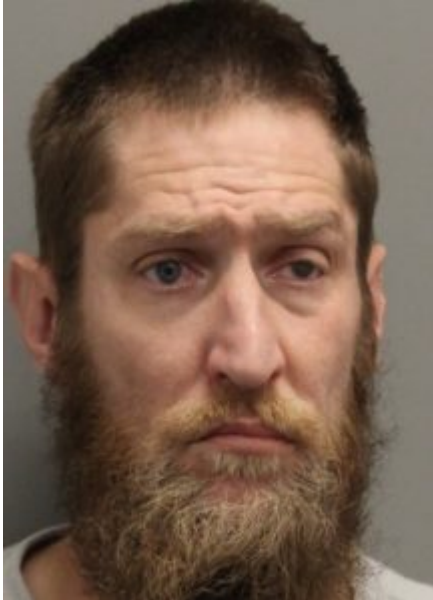
On March 2, 2026, at approximately 2:20 p.m., members of the Kent County Governor's Task Force responded to the 800 block of Artis Drive in Dover to locate Christopher Naylor, who had a capias warrant for failure to appear in New Castle County Court of Common Pleas. When detectives arrived, they saw Naylor exiting a tent in the backyard of the property. He was taken into custody without incident. While taking him into custody, detectives saw drugs and drug paraphernalia in plain view in the tent.

During a search of the tent, detectives found the following items:

- Approximately 10.13 grams of methamphetamines
- Digital scale

- Drug paraphernalia

Naylor was taken to Troop 3, where he was charged with the crimes listed below, arraigned by Justice of the Peace Court 11, and committed to Sussex Correctional Institution on a \$15,001 secured bond.

State Police Arrest Dover Woman for 5th Offense DUI

The Delaware State Police arrested 59-year-old **Jacqueline Bolden**, of Dover, Delaware, for felony 5th offense DUI, and related traffic charges, following a traffic stop Monday night in Dover.

On March 2, 2026, at approximately 10:25 p.m., a trooper saw a Chevrolet Tahoe traveling northbound on South DuPont Highway near Walnut Shade Road with a registration violation. The trooper pulled the Tahoe over and spoke to the driver, identified as Jacqueline Bolden, who showed multiple signs of impairment. Standardized Field Sobriety Tests were administered, and after the tests, she was arrested for driving under the influence.

A computer check showed that Bolden had four prior DUI-related convictions.

Bolden was taken to Troop 3, where she was charged with the offenses listed below, arraigned by Justice of the Peace Court 11, and committed to Sussex Correctional Institution on a \$6,600 secured bond.

State Police Arrest Car Wash Employee for Theft in Wilmington

The Delaware State Police have arrested 24-year-old **Jose Gonzales-Morales** of Wilmington, Delaware, for theft following an investigation into a stolen engagement ring at the car wash where he worked in Wilmington.

On February 15, 2026, troopers responded to the Magic Car Wash located at 3221 Naamans Road in Wilmington for a theft complaint. Troopers learned that after a customer had their car washed, their engagement ring was missing from inside the car, where they had mistakenly left it. Troopers spoke with several car wash employees, including Gonzales-Morales, but the ring could not be recovered.

Troopers later learned that the victim had provided area pawn shops with a flyer showing a picture of the missing ring in case someone tried to pawn it. That effort proved to be successful. On February 23, 2026, Gonzales-Morales responded to a Wilmington-area pawn shop where he attempted to pawn the ring. The pawn shop owner, having previously received a flyer, recovered the ring and returned it to the victim.

On February 28, 2026, Gonzales-Morales was arrested without incident and taken to Troop 1, where he was charged with the following offenses, arraigned by the Justice of the Peace Court 11, and released on a \$2,500 unsecured bond.
