

State Police Arrest Senior Living Facility Employee for Theft from Resident

The Delaware State Police arrested 62-year-old **Kem Mays**, of Wilmington, Delaware, on felony burglary and theft charges after stealing from the resident of a senior living facility Sunday morning in Wilmington.

On February 15, 2026, at approximately 10:30 a.m., troopers responded to Forwood Estates, located at 1912 Marsh Road, in Wilmington, for a reported theft. The preliminary investigation revealed that at approximately 8:30 a.m., the victim, who lives at the facility, left their apartment. Shortly afterwards, a facility employee, later identified as Mays, unlawfully entered the victim's apartment and stole jewelry.

Troopers contacted Mays during the investigation and recovered the stolen jewelry, which was returned to the victim.

Mays was taken into custody without incident and transported to Troop 1. He was charged with the below listed offenses, arraigned by Justice of the Peace Court 11, and released on a \$12,000 unsecured bond.

State Police Arrest Maryland Man for Attempted Burglary in Marydel

The Delaware State Police have arrested 19-year-old **Ryan Harding**, of Henderson, Maryland, for attempted burglary and related charges.

On February 8, 2026, detectives began investigating an attempted burglary at Smoke Needs, located at 825 Halltown Road in Marydel. Detectives learned that during the overnight hours, an unknown suspect, wearing dark clothing, gloves, and mask, attempted to force entry into the business with a hammer. On February 15, 2026, at approximately 2:15 a.m., detectives saw a Toyota Camry park on Halltown Road near Smoke Needs and contacted the driver, identified as Ryan Harding, who was wearing dark clothing and latex gloves. He was detained without incident. Through investigative means, detectives learned that Harding was planning to burglarize the business and identified him as the suspect in the previous burglary attempt. Detectives found burglary tools in the Camry following a consent search of the car.

Harding was arrested and taken to Troop 3, where he was charged with the crimes listed below, arraigned by Justice of the Peace Court 3, and released on a \$3,100 unsecured bond.

State Police Arrest Seaford Man for 6th Offense DUI

The Delaware State Police arrested 44-year-old **Marrco Bryant**, of Seaford, Delaware, on a 6th offense felony DUI and related charges following a traffic stop Friday night in Harrington.

On February 13, 2026, at approximately 11:00 p.m., a trooper patrolling South Dupont Highway, near Williamsville Road, saw a Ford F-150 traveling southbound with an equipment violation. The trooper stopped the Ford and spoke with the driver, later identified as Bryant, who showed several signs of impairment. The trooper asked Bryant to perform Standardized Field Sobriety Tests during which he showed additional indicators of impairment. Bryant was taken into custody without incident.

During a search of the vehicle, troopers found empty bottles of alcohol. A computer search of Bryant revealed his driver's license was suspended and that he had five prior DUI convictions.

Bryant was taken to Troop 3 where he was charged with the below listed offenses, arraigned by Justice of the Peace Court 11, and committed to the Sussex Correctional Institution on a \$5,101 cash bond.

Search Warrant in Long Neck Leads to Arrest for Drug and Weapon Offenses

The Delaware State Police have arrested 56-year-old **Joseph Anderson** of Millsboro, Delaware, for felony drug and weapons charges following a search warrant yesterday in Long Neck.

On February 11, 2026, members of the Sussex County Governor's Task Force, Sussex County Drug Unit, and the Delaware State Police Special Operations Response Team, executed a search warrant at a property on Ritter Drive in Long Neck. The search warrant was obtained following an investigation of Joseph Anderson for the distribution of illegal narcotics from the residence. During the search warrant, Anderson previously discarded narcotics in the kitchen sink, and he was detained without incident.

A search of the property led to the discovery of the following items:

- 12-gauge double barrel shotgun
- 12-gauge pump shotgun
- 12-gauge single shot shotgun
- .50 caliber muzzleloader
- .22 caliber handgun
- Assorted ammunition
- Approximately 4.11 grams of methamphetamine
- 1 Diazepam pill
- Digital scales
- Drug paraphernalia

Anderson was arrested and taken to Troop 4, where he was charged with the crimes listed below, arraigned by Justice of the Peace Court 2, and committed to Sussex Correctional Institution on a \$67,500 secured bond.

State Police Investigating a Single-Vehicle Fatal Crash in Millsboro

The Delaware State Police is investigating a single-vehicle fatal crash that occurred Wednesday night in Millsboro.

On February 11, 2026, at approximately 11:50 p.m., an Audi A4 was traveling southbound on Legion Road, approaching a sharp left curve in the area of Buttercream Hills, a private driveway. For reasons currently under investigation, the vehicle failed to negotiate the curve and exited the west edge of the roadway before striking a concrete culvert pipe. The vehicle became airborne and then overturned before striking a row of trees.

The driver, a 60-year-old man from Millsboro, was not wearing his seatbelt and was ejected from the vehicle during the crash. He was pronounced dead at the scene. His name is being withheld until his family is notified.

The investigation is still ongoing by the Delaware State Police Collision Reconstruction Unit. Troopers ask anyone who witnessed the crash to contact Sergeant A. Mitchell at (302) 703- 3269. State Police Arrest Two Men on Felony Drug Charges Following Traffic Stop in New Castle

The Delaware State Police arrested 45-year-old **William Comer Jr.**, from Wilmington, Delaware, and 59-year-old **Darrell Maxion**, from Bear, Delaware, on felony drug dealing and related charges following a traffic stop early Monday morning in New Castle.

On February 9, 2026, at approximately 1:30 a.m., a trooper was patrolling Memorial Drive, near North Dupont Highway, when the trooper saw a Volvo XC90 with an equipment violation. The trooper pulled over the vehicle and spoke with the driver, Comer, and passenger, Maxion. While talking to Comer, troopers learned he had drug paraphernalia in his possession. A subsequent search of the Volvo and its occupants resulted in the discovery of the following items:

- Approximately 34 grams of suspected crack cocaine
- Approximately 0.99 grams of suspect heroin
- Two digital scales

-Drug packaging materials

Comer and Maxion were taken into custody without incident and transported to Troop 2.

Comer was charged with the below listed offenses, arraigned by Justice of the Peace Court 11, and committed to the Howard R. Young Correctional Institution on a \$42,450 secured bond.

State Police Arrest Lincoln Man for 5th Offense DUI and Terroristic Threatening

The Delaware State Police have arrested 44-year-old **Jose Sanchez** of Lincoln, Delaware, for 5th offense DUI, terroristic threatening and related offenses, after he threatened a co-worker in Georgetown.

On February 9, 2026, at approximately 9:45 a.m., troopers responded to Donovan's Salvage Works, located at 20269 Donovan's Road in Georgetown, for a report of a terroristic

threatening. When troopers arrived, they learned that the suspect, identified as Jose Sanchez, was involved in an argument with a co-worker. During the argument, Sanchez threatened to leave, return with a gun, and kill the co-worker. Troopers spoke to Sanchez on the phone and learned that his car had broken down on Seashore Highway in Georgetown. Troopers located Sanchez in his car on Seashore Highway and when they spoke to him, he showed multiple signs of impairment. Sanchez refused Standardized Field Sobriety Tests, and he was taken into custody without incident. During an inventory search of Sanchez's car, troopers found a sword concealed under clothing on the front seat.

A computer check showed that Sanchez had four prior DUI related convictions and a revoked driver's license.

Sanchez was arrested and taken to Troop 4, where he was charged with the crimes listed below, arraigned by Justice of the Peace Court 3, and committed to Sussex Correctional Institution on a \$6,700 secured bond.

hurt.
