

State Police Investigating Fatal Accident Involving Bicyclist

The Delaware State Police are investigating a fatal accident that occurred in Harrington last night where a bicyclist was struck and killed.

On January 16, 2023, at approximately 5:42 p.m., a 2009 white Honda Element was stopped at the stop sign on westbound Corn Crib Road at the intersection with northbound South Dupont Highway (US Route 13). At the same time, a 65-year-old man was riding his bicycle southbound in the northbound shoulder of South Dupont Highway at this intersection. The driver of the Element pulled away from the stop sign to cross the northbound lanes of South Dupont Highway, and in doing so he struck the bicyclist in the shoulder of the roadway. The man on the bicycle was propelled into the right northbound lane of South Dupont Highway, and the Element stopped in the median. Very shortly afterwards, the bicyclist was struck a second time by a 2017 Ford F-250 that was traveling northbound on South Dupont Highway in the right lane. The pickup truck dragged the victim a short distance before coming to a stop on the shoulder.

The bicyclist, a 65-year-old man from Harrington, Delaware, was pronounced dead at the scene. Identification of the victim is pending notification to his family and relatives. The driver of the Honda Element, a 30-year-old man from Houston, Delaware, was wearing his seatbelt and was not injured. The driver of the Ford F-250, a 65-year-old man from Dover, Delaware, was also wearing his seatbelt and was not injured.



No other vehicles were involved in this collision. The roadway was closed for approximately 3.5 hours while the scene was

investigated and cleared.

Detectives Investigating Shooting That Left One Man Seriously Injured

The Delaware State Police are currently investigating a shooting that occurred in Magnolia yesterday afternoon that left one man seriously injured.

On January 15, 2023, at approximately 4:03 p.m., troopers responded to Lambert Drive in Meadowbrook Acres regarding a man who had been shot. Troopers contacted the 32-year-old victim, who had been shot in his abdomen an unknown number of times. The victim was flown to an area hospital for emergency surgery, where he is currently in stable condition.

No one else was harmed during this incident. There is no suspect information available, and the circumstances and motive surrounding the shooting remain under investigation.

Troopers Arrest Newark Man on Drug Dealing Charges

The Delaware State Police have arrested 37-year-old **Wilfri Moreno-Garcia** of Newark, Delaware on drug dealing charges following a car stop last night in Wilmington.

During the month of January 2023, troopers were informed that a man driving a silver Ford Escape with a Delaware temporary tag had been selling cocaine to buyers along the Kirkwood Highway corridor in Wilmington. Last night, troopers learned that this same person was actively selling drugs in the area of Kirkwood Highway and Newport Gap Pike from his car. At approximately 8:40 p.m., troopers located the silver Ford Escape with a Delaware temporary tag and made contact with the

driver, identified as Wilfri Moreno-Garcia. Moreno-Garcia attempted to hide something in his pocket and physically resisted arrest, but he was taken into custody at the scene a short time later. A search of Moreno-Garcia led to the discovery of approximately 14.75 grams of crack cocaine and approximately 2.8 grams of powder cocaine.

Moreno-Garcia was taken to Troop 6, where he was charged with the following crimes:

- Possession With Intent to Deliver a Controlled Substance in a Tier 2 Quantity (Felony)
- Possession With Intent to Deliver a Controlled Substance (Felony)
- Resisting Arrest

Moreno-Garcia was arraigned by Justice of the Peace Court 11 and committed to Howard R. Young Correctional Institution on \$26,000 cash bond.

Collision

Delaware State Police are investigating a fatal motor vehicle collision that claimed the lives of two individuals last night in the Frankford area.

The collision occurred on January 14, 2023, at approximately 9:11 p.m., when a 1997 Chevrolet Silverado was traveling westbound on Roxana Road, east of McCary Road at a high rate of speed. As the Chevrolet approached a left curve in the roadway, the operator failed to negotiate the curve and the right-side tires of the Chevrolet left the roadway. The operator swerved to re-enter the roadway and the Chevrolet began skidding sideways in a southwesterly direction. The Chevrolet skidded across the roadway and then exited the north edge of Roxana Road, where it overturned. The Chevrolet continued overturning, striking a small tree and then the right rear side of a parked 2005 Chevrolet Silverado in the driveway of a residence located in the 36000 block of Roxana Road. The 1997 Chevrolet continued in a southwesterly direction, where it struck an attached garage at the same residence.

The 28-year-old male operator of the Chevrolet from Selbyville, DE, who was not properly restrained, was transported to an area hospital where he was pronounced deceased. The identification of the victim is pending notification to the next of kin.

The 3-year-old female passenger in the Chevrolet from Selbyville, DE, was not properly restrained, and was pronounced deceased at the scene. The identification of the victim is pending notification to the next of kin.

Roxana Road was closed for approximately 7 hours while the crash was investigated, and the roadway cleared.

Troopers Arrest Philadelphia Man for Felony Drug Possession

The Delaware State Police have arrested 24-year-old **Kyeef Williams** of Philadelphia, Pennsylvania on several felony drug charges after he was found to be in possession of a large amount of narcotics. Williams was contacted yesterday

afternoon during a traffic stop in Dover.

On January 12, 2023, at approximately 3:55 p.m., troopers observed Williams driving a 2019 Toyota Camry southbound on State Route 1 near the Dover Toll Plaza. Troopers were familiar with Williams and knew that he did not have a valid driver's license. A traffic stop was conducted on Williams on State Route 1 south of the Puncheon Run Connector. Troopers contacted Williams and asked him to exit the car, and he did so without incident. During the course of the stop, a narcotics canine scanned the Camry and positively alerted to the presence of drugs. A search of the car led to the discovery of approximately 465.82 grams (over one pound) of crystal methamphetamine, approximately 8.06 grams of crack cocaine, and approximately 1.05 grams of suspected heroin.

Williams was taken into custody at the scene and taken to Troop 3, where he was charged with the following offenses:

- Possession With Intent to Deliver a Controlled Substance in a Tier 3 Quantity (Felony)
- Possession of a Controlled Substance in a Tier 3 Quantity (Felony)
- Possession With Intent to Deliver a Controlled Substance (Felony) – 2 counts
- Possession of a Controlled Substance in a Tier 1 Quantity (Felony) – 2 counts
- Driving Without a Valid License

Williams was arraigned by Justice of the Peace Court 2 and committed to Sussex Correctional Institution on \$122,050 cash bond.

Four Subjects Arrested on Various Charges Following Suspicious Vehicle Investigation

The Delaware State Police have arrested four people on various criminal charges following an investigation into a suspicious vehicle in Harbeson early yesterday morning.

On January 11, 2023, at approximately 5:48 a.m., troopers responded to Phillips Branch Road east of Indian Mission Road after receiving a call of a suspicious vehicle in the area. Troopers were advised that it had appeared that a woman had been involved in an altercation with two men outside of the car. Troopers located a 2016 blue Honda Civic and contacted the four occupants. The driver, identified as **Samuel Mondestin**, 19, of Seaford, Delaware, had a suspicious item visibly protruding from his sock. This item was discovered to be a small bottle that contained approximately 5.01 grams of cocaine. Mondestin was also discovered to be in possession of ammunition and approximately 0.028 grams of suspected heroin. Mondestin was taken into custody without incident.

After the drugs were discovered, troopers asked the other three occupants to exit the vehicle. Both rear passengers, identified as **Witley Francin**, 19, of Lincoln, Delaware, and **Ryan Simpson**, 18, of Milford, Delaware, did not comply, and both physically resisted arrest. Despite this, troopers were able to take Francin and Simpson into custody after a short time. A search of Francin led to the discovery of approximately 5.99 grams of crack cocaine, and a search of Simpson led to the discovery of a pair of brass knuckles and 14 prescription pills. Front-seat passenger **Jocelyn Flores-Estrada**, 20, of Milton, Delaware, also resisted arrest, but was taken into custody at the scene.

Troopers searched the Honda Civic and recovered a loaded Ruger handgun and approximately 2.43 grams of marijuana. The handgun had been reported as stolen by the Dover Police Department in August 2022. Mondestin was also found to be violating an active court order prohibiting him from possessing firearms.

All four defendants were taken to Troop 7 and charged with the following crimes:

Mondestin was arraigned by Justice of the Peace Court 2 and committed to Sussex Correctional Institution on \$41,500 cash bond.
