Delaware State Police Arrest Multiple Subjects Following Drug Dealing Investigation

Delaware State Police have arrested numerous subjects following a narcotics investigation that began in June 2022 in the Ellendale and Greenwood areas.

During the months of June 2022 through August 2022, the Delaware State Police corroborated with the Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA) to identify several residences and property lots in the Unity Lane area of Greenwood (informally known as "The Hole") and the Metz Lane area of Ellendale that were actively involved in the distribution of narcotics. On August 31, 2022, the Delaware State Police, with assistance provided by the DEA, Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI), Dover Police Department, and Delaware Probation & Parole, executed a series of search warrants at these locations, which resulted in the seizure of the following contraband:

- Approximately 9.261 grams of heroin
- Approximately 727.49 grams of crack cocaine
- Approximately 5.8 grams of powder cocaine
- Approximately 1.9 pounds of marijuana
- Approximately \$8,700 in suspected drug proceeds
- 3 handguns
- 1 muzzleloader
- 2 rifles, one of which was reported stolen out of Troop

3 in August 2022

- Numerous rounds of ammunition
- Drug paraphernalia

Several subjects were taken into custody at these locations and transported to Troop 3, where they were charged with the following crimes:

Richard Boyd, 54, of Greenwood, DE:

- Possession With Intent to Deliver a Controlled Substance (Felony) – 3 counts
- Possession of Drug Paraphernalia

Boyd was arraigned by Justice of the Peace Court # 2 and committed to Sussex Correctional Institution on \$15,500 cash bond.

Alexander Marsh, 59, of Greenwood, DE:

- Possession With Intent to Deliver a Controlled Substance (Felony) – 2 counts
- Resisting Arrest

Marsh was arraigned by Justice of the Peace Court # 2 and committed to Sussex Correctional Institution on \$10,000 secured bond.

Robert Reed, 54, of Greenwood, DE:

- Possession of a Firearm by a Person Prohibited (Felony)
- Possession of Ammunition by a Person Prohibited (Felony)
- Resisting Arrest
- Criminal Solicitation Third Degree

Reed was arraigned by Justice of the Peace Court # 2 and committed to Sussex Correctional Institution on \$8,000 secured bond.

Taquen Owens, 28, of Ellendale, DE:

- Resisting Arrest
- Criminal Solicitation Third Degree
- Possession of a Controlled Substance

Owens was issued a criminal summons and released from police custody.

On September 1, 2022, **Jermaine Boyd, Jr.**, 31, of Dover, DE turned himself in to Troop 3, where he was charged with the following offenses:

- Resisting Arrest
- Criminal Solicitation Third Degree

Boyd, Jr. was arraigned by Justice of the Peace Court # 2 and released on his own recognizance. However, he was ultimately committed to Sussex Correctional Institution after a Violation of Probation warrant was issued by Probation & Parole.

On September 1, 2022, **Jermain Boyd, Sr.**, 50, of Harrington, DE turned himself in to Troop 3, where he was charged with the following offenses:

- Possession With Intent to Deliver a Controlled Substance in a Tier 3 Quantity (Felony)
- Possession With Intent to Deliver a Controlled Substance (Felony) – 9 counts
- Possession of Drug Paraphernalia

Boyd, Sr. was arraigned by Justice of the Peace Court # 2 and committed to Sussex Correctional Institution on \$70,500 secured bond.

Troopers Arrest Two Subjects for Felony Drug Charges

Delaware State Police have arrested 25-year-old **Chanel Fosque** of Lincoln, DE and 28-year-old **Christopher Thomas** of Lincoln, DE for felony narcotics charges following an investigation that occurred in the Lincoln area on Tuesday afternoon.

On August 30, 2022, at approximately 1:00 p.m., troopers responded to a residence on the 22000 block of Pine Haven Road in an attempt to locate Chanel Fosque, who had several active warrants for her arrest. Upon their arrival, troopers contacted Fosque along with her two juvenile children inside

the residence. Further investigation revealed Fosque had approximately 3.64 grams of suspected heroin, approximately 5.15 grams of marijuana, and drug paraphernalia stored inside of the home. The second suspect, Christopher Thomas, who also lives at the residence, was not present at the time of the incident. Thomas later turned himself in at Troop 4.

Fosque was taken into custody without incident and transported to Troop 4, where she was charged with the following crimes:

- Possession With Intent to Deliver a Controlled Substance in a Tier 2 Quantity (Felony)
- Endangering the Welfare of a Child – 2 counts
- Possession of Drug Paraphernalia – 2 counts
- Possession of Marijuana

Fosque was arraigned by Justice of the Peace Court # 2 and released on \$7,100 unsecured bond.

Thomas was charged with the following crimes:

- Possession With Intent to Deliver a Controlled Substance in a Tier 2 Quantity (Felony)
- Endangering the Welfare of a Child – 2 counts
- Possession of Drug Paraphernalia

Thomas was arraigned by Justice of the Peace Court # 2 and released on \$6,500 unsecured bond.

Delaware State Police Phone Number Used in Spoofed Phone Number Scam

The Delaware State Police is issuing the following advisory for a recurring phone scam involving a “spoofed phone number.”

The Delaware State Police is aware of multiple incidents in which individuals have received phone calls from a Delaware State Police-issued telephone number. Only the number appears on the caller ID; if that number is looked up, it shows that it is a valid Delaware State Police phone number.

Caller ID spoofing is when a caller deliberately falsifies the information transmitted to your caller ID display to disguise their identity. Spoofing is often used to trick someone into giving away valuable personal information so it can be used in fraudulent activity or sold illegally.

This is a reminder that the Delaware State Police will never request payment for fines, traffic tickets, or bail. All these

transactions are conducted by the respective court systems and never over the phone. Electronic payments are also never requested via phone for court matters.

If someone calls you regarding a family member, do not offer personal information about yourself or the family member. Immediately attempt to contact the family to verify their status on your own. Indicators of scam calls are threats, orders not to hang up, and other statements where the scammer places urgency on their request for information or money.

Delaware State Police Investigating Fatal Motorcycle Collision

Delaware State Police are investigating a fatal motor vehicle collision involving a motorcycle that occurred in the Felton area on Monday evening.

On August 29, 2022, at approximately 11:30 p.m., a blue 2008 Suzuki sport-style motorcycle was traveling westbound on Burnite Mill Road approaching the intersection with Berrytown Road. The operator of the motorcycle crossed the double-yellow line on Burnite Mill Road to pass another vehicle that was traveling westbound in front of him. After passing this vehicle, the motorcyclist moved back into the westbound lane of travel. However, in doing so the operator lost control of the motorcycle and exited the northern edge of the roadway. The motorcycle then struck several trees, which led to the operator sustaining critical injuries.

The motorcyclist, a 28-year-old male from Ridgely, Maryland, was transported from the scene to an area hospital. He succumbed to his injuries earlier this morning. Identification of the victim is pending notification to the next of kin.

No other vehicles were involved in this incident. No other injuries were reported. The roadway was closed for approximately 2.5 hours while the collision was being investigated and cleared.

Delaware State Police Investigating Fatal Pedestrian Collision

Delaware State Police are investigating a fatal motor vehicle collision involving a pedestrian that occurred in the New Castle area on Sunday evening.

On August 28, 2022, at approximately 8:14 p.m., a red 2013 Toyota Highlander was traveling westbound on Boulden Boulevard approaching the intersection at Southgate Boulevard. As the Highlander approached this intersection, a pedestrian entered the westbound lane of Boulden Boulevard and into the path of the vehicle. As a result, the front of the vehicle struck the pedestrian while he was in the roadway. After the collision, the vehicle fled the area and continued westbound. A short time later, an officer from the New Castle County Police Department conducted a traffic stop on the Highlander on Marrows Road north of White Chapel Drive. Both the driver and

passenger were subsequently taken into custody without incident.

The pedestrian involved in this incident, a 54-year-old male from New Castle, Delaware, was pronounced deceased at the scene. Identification of the victim is pending notification to the next of kin. Both the driver of the Highlander, a 30-year-old male from Baltimore, Maryland, and the passenger, a 37-year-old male from Newark, Delaware, were properly restrained. Neither occupant was injured in the collision.

No other vehicles were involved in this incident. The roadway was not illuminated at the time, and there are no pedestrian crosswalks in the area. The victim was wearing dark-colored clothing and did not appear to be carrying a lighted device. The roadway was closed for approximately three hours while the collision was being investigated and cleared.

***Traffic Advisory* Delaware State Police Investigating Serious Collision**
