

# Troopers Arrest Subject on DUI and Drug Charges Following Traffic Stop

Delaware State Police have arrested 43-year-old **Charles Comegys** of Sudlersville, Maryland on DUI and drug charges following a traffic stop that occurred in the Camden area on Saturday evening.

On June 18, 2022 at approximately 5:57 p.m., a trooper on patrol observed a gray GMC Sierra traveling westbound on Charles Polk Road at the intersection of John Clarke Road. The operator of the Sierra appeared to be falling asleep behind the wheel, and the pickup truck struck a posted stop sign at this intersection. The trooper attempted to conduct a traffic stop on the truck on POW-MIA Parkway, but the operator failed to stop. The Sierra continued onto southbound South Dupont Highway, and the trooper noticed that the driver threw a bag out of the window and onto the road. The operator committed several other moving violations before coming to a stop on Old North Road west of Old Camden Road. Contact was made with the driver, identified as Charles Comegys, who showed signs of impairment. A DUI investigation ensued, and Comegys was taken into custody at the scene without further incident. A search of the Sierra led to the discovery of drug paraphernalia. The discarded bag was recovered from South Dupont Highway, and it was found to contain approximately 31.68 grams of suspected heroin.

Comegys was transported to Troop 3 and charged with the following offenses:

- Possession of a Controlled Substance in a Tier 3 Quantity (Felony)
- Possession With Intent to Deliver a Controlled Substance

- in a Tier 3 Quantity (Felony)
- Tampering With Physical Evidence (Felony)
- Disregarding a Police Officer Signal (Felony)
- Possession of Drug Paraphernalia
- Driving a Vehicle Under the Influence of Drugs
- Numerous traffic offenses

Comegys was arraigned by Justice of the Peace Court # 7 and committed to Sussex Correctional Institution on \$62,406 cash bond.

# Store Robbery

Delaware State Police are investigating an armed robbery that occurred in the New Castle area on Sunday morning.

On June 19, 2022 at approximately 5:24 a.m., an unknown male subject entered the Royal Farms convenience store located at 2160 New Castle Avenue and approached the cashier's counter. The suspect confronted an employee with a rifle and demanded money and cigarettes. After the victim complied, the suspect fled from the business on foot and was last seen running southbound through the gas station parking lot towards an unknown destination. Troopers responded to the scene and canvassed the surrounding area but were unable to locate the suspect. No one was injured in this incident.

The suspect is described as a black male in his 20's, approximately 6'00" tall with a thin build. There are no surveillance images available at this time.

# **Delaware State Police Investigating Fatal Pedestrian Collision**

Delaware State Police are investigating a fatal motor vehicle collision that occurred in the Delaware City area on Sunday morning.

On June 19, 2022 at approximately 12:31 a.m., a white 2014 Chevrolet Cruze was traveling northbound on South Dupont Highway just north of the intersection at Mid-County Drive. At this time, a 37-year-old female pedestrian from Philadelphia, Pennsylvania was crossing South Dupont Highway from west to east and entered into the path of the Cruze. As a result, the right front of the Cruze struck the pedestrian in the roadway.

Both the operator, a 24-year-old woman from Wilmington, DE, and the passenger, a 24-year-old woman from Middletown, DE, were properly restrained. Neither individual requested medical attention at the scene. The female pedestrian was not carrying any lighting device and was not utilizing a crosswalk at the time of the incident. She sustained critical injuries and was transported via ambulance to an area hospital, where she was later pronounced deceased. Identification of the victim is pending notification to the next-of-kin.

No other injuries were reported. The roadway was closed for approximately three hours while the collision was investigated and cleared.

# Investigating Bank Robbery

Delaware State Police are investigating a bank robbery that occurred in the Newark area on Friday afternoon.

On June 17, 2022 at approximately 1:43 p.m., troopers responded to the Wells Fargo bank located at 2450 Glasgow Avenue for an alarm activation. Upon their arrival it was discovered that the bank had just been robbed and the suspect had fled the scene. The ensuing investigation revealed that the suspect had entered the bank and presented a teller with a demand note. The teller surrendered money to the suspect, and the suspect exited the building and departed from the area in an unknown direction towards an unknown destination. No one was injured in this incident.

## **Delaware State Police Seeking Public's Assistance Solving 30-Year-Old Homicide of Elva J. Poore**

Delaware State Police Homicide Unit continues investigating the 1992 murder of **Elva J. Poore, 17, of Chesapeake City, Maryland.**

On June 17, 1992, at 8:13 a.m., the body of a white female was discovered along the edge of US 13, north of Odessa. The victim was turned over to the Division of Forensic Science for an autopsy. The Medical Examiner ruled the manner of death as a Homicide. Elva was approximately 5' 4", 105 lbs., with brown hair and brown eyes.

Elva Poore left her residence on Sunday, June 14, 1992, and traveled to Ocean City, MD, with four friends from Chesapeake City. The purpose of the trip was to celebrate "Senior Week." She did not tell her parents she was going on the trip but did leave a note stating she would be away with a friend.

While in Ocean City, Elva stayed with other friends at the Ocean Lodge Motel, but they were asked to leave due to excessive noise. She was last seen walking from Ocean Lodge

Motel to the Admiral Hotel in Ocean City at 3:00 a.m. on June 16th. She was not seen again by anyone who knew her.

# Delaware State Police Investigating Fatal Motor Vehicle Collision

Delaware State Police are investigating a fatal motor vehicle collision that occurred in the Milford area on Friday morning.

On June 17, 2022 at approximately 5:31 a.m., a blue 2020 Mazda 6 was traveling westbound on Wilkins Road east of Elks Lodge Road. For unknown reasons, the Mazda failed to maintain travel in its lane and exited the south edge of the roadway. The Mazda continued proceeding in a southwestern direction and struck a traffic signpost. The vehicle continued past the signpost until its front center struck a large tree off the

roadway. The Mazda then spun in a clockwise manner and came to rest at this location.
