Delaware State Police Investigating Single Vehicle Fatal Collision

Delaware State Police are investigating a single fatal motor vehicle collision that occurred in the Wilmington area on Friday evening.

On May 13, 2022, at approximately 10:41 p.m., a 2003 Chevrolet Silverado was traveling westbound on Murphy Road west of the intersection at Foulk Road. During this time, the operator of the pickup truck lost control of the vehicle, overcorrected his steering, and began to cross the double-yellow line on Murphy Road. The operator then overcorrected a second time and proceeded back into the westbound lane of Murphy Road. The pickup truck continued traveling off the roadway until its left front struck a utility pole on the north side of the roadway, causing the operator to be ejected from the truck. The Silverado came to rest a short distance away after striking a nearby fence.

The operator of the Silverado, a 25-year-old male from Garnet Valley, PA, was not properly restrained. He was transported to an area hospital by ambulance in critical condition. The driver later succumbed to his injuries and was pronounced deceased on May 14, 2022. Identification of the victim is pending notification to the next-of-kin.

No other vehicles were involved in this incident, and no other injuries were reported.

Honors Those Who Made The Supreme Sacrifice

Throughout the first half of May, the Delaware State Police commemorated the memories and families of police officers who died in the line of duty, making the ultimate sacrifice protecting while serving their communities. On May 4, 2022, DSP hosted the annual Memorial Service and wreath-laying where troopers, surviving family members, and friends gathered at the DSP Headquarters memorial to honor the 24 troopers who have fallen over the agency's 99-year history. Later that day, DSP also joined the statewide remembrance ceremony at the Delaware Law Enforcement Memorial outside Legislative Hall.

Between May 11th and 13th, troopers were among nearly 2,600 cyclists traversing the 25th Police Unity Tour, embarking on the long and strenuous journey from New Jersey, through Delaware, with the final stop in Washington D.C., for the 34th Annual Candlelight Vigil on May 13th. Ceremonies culminated on May 15th, a federally sanctioned holiday since 1962, with the national wreath-laying at Washington, D.C. This year while Corporal Keith Heacock of the Delmar Police Department was added to the National Law Enforcement Officers Memorial, troopers continued to embrace Cpl. Heacock's family and friends with support and respect.



Captain Mary McGuire, Troop 7 Commander, was among the officers who participated for the second time in the Police Unity Tour. She stated, "As for me 20 years later, this ride was much more challenging, and I commend all those who committed to the miles ridden. Spending this time 'Riding for those who died' will forever be etched into my memory. To give back just a small part of ourselves to the survivors who awaited us as we arrived at the National Law Enforcement Memorial is worth every mile ridden. Seeing the faces of survivors as we entered the memorial- including such a strong young man as Matthew Heacock – was 'The Reward.'"



Thank you to our dedicated officers throughout the state for their unwavering service. The sacrifices of our fallen officers inspire those who remain to never take a single day for granted and to continue the legacy that our heroes left

behind. "Always loved...never forgotten...forever missed" □

Delaware State Police Arrest Subject for Theft of a Motor Vehicle

Delaware State Police have arrested **David Harris**, 33, of Smyrna, DE, for theft of a motor vehicle and related charges following an incident Saturday morning.

On May 14, 2022, at approximately 05:02 a.m., troopers responded to Wheatleys Pond Road in Smyrna to assist Smyrna Police Department in a search for a suspect who fled from a collision scene after being involved in a pursuit with Smyrna Police Department. The suspect, later identified as David Harris, was located at his residence in Smyrna and taken into custody without further incident. Investigation revealed David was operating a stolen vehicle he took earlier in the morning from a residence on the 800 block of West Mount Vernon Street in Smyrna. Also stolen from the victim's vehicle was \$270 worth of property.

David was transported back to Smyrna Police Department and charged with the following crimes:

- Theft of a Motor Vehicle (Felony)
- Theft under \$1500
- Criminal Trespass

David was arraigned in Justice of the Peace Court # 7 and committed to Sussex Correctional Institute on a \$4000 secured bond. All pursuit-related crimes were charged by Smyrna Police Department.

Troopers Arrest Subject on Drug Charges Following Traffic Stop

Delaware State Police have arrested 28-year-old **Evon Lynch** of Wilmington, DE on drug charges following a traffic stop that occurred Thursday evening.

On May 12, 2022, at approximately 8:06 p.m., a trooper on patrol in the Wilmington area observed a gray Kia Sportage traveling southbound on Philadelphia Pike at Marsh Road at a high rate of speed. The trooper conducted a traffic stop on the vehicle on North Market Street and made contact with the operator, identified as Evon Lynch. A computer inquiry of Lynch revealed that he had a suspended driver's license and active warrants for his arrest. Lynch was subsequently taken into custody at the scene without incident. An ensuing search of the Kia led to the discovery of approximately 110 prescription opioid pills and approximately 69.69 grams of

marijuana.

Lynch was transported to Troop 1 and charged with the following offenses:

- Possession With Intent to Deliver a Controlled Substance in a Tier 3 Quantity (Felony)
- Possession of a Controlled Substance in a Tier 3 Quantity (Felony)
- Possession of Marijuana Other Than Personal Use Quantity
- Driving While Suspended / Revoked
- Speeding

Lynch was arraigned by Justice of the Peace Court # 11 and committed to Howard R. Young Correctional Institution on \$41,600 secured bond.

Delaware State Police Encourage Everyone to “Lock Up! Every Night!”

The Delaware State Police continually investigate thefts from motor vehicle complaints. These crimes result in the loss of money, electronics, personal belongings of value, personal identification, **and FIREARMS**. Nearly all these complaints result from the owner leaving the vehicle **unsecured overnight**. These crimes are avoidable by simply taking the extra time to ensure that your vehicles are locked while parked at your residence. Delaware State Police want to share the importance of “**Lock Up! Every Night!**” to combat this preventable crime trend.

The Delaware State Police are offering the following prevention and awareness tips:

- Always keep the doors of your unattended vehicles **locked** and the windows **shut**.
- Do not leave **items of value** in your vehicle. These items include purses, wallets, credit cards, electronics, checkbooks, money, Social Security cards, loose change, documents, and paperwork with your printed personal information.
- Store **valuable tools** inside your residence. If needed daily for work, create an easy system to load and unload, such as using storage containers to transport.
- Lock your **glove box**, which should only store your registration and insurance cards. Do not store your vehicle title in the glove box. Store it in a safe place in your residence.
- Clear the vehicle of all **clutter** and personal items. This can give the general impression that other property of value may be kept within the vehicle.

- Do not keep a **spare vehicle key** hidden in the same vehicle. Do not store house keys or other keys in your vehicle.
- If possible, keep your vehicle parked under a **lighted area** that you can check from your residence.
- If you have a **surveillance security system**, include your vehicle in the angle of your camera. If you locate a suspicious subject on your property or around your vehicle, do not confront them. Instead, call 9-1-1 immediately.

And finally, **be a good witness** for your neighbors, co-workers, and fellow citizens. Pay attention and be aware of what is going on in your neighborhood and other places that you frequent throughout the course of your day.

Avoid taking a false security mindset. These crimes happen in all communities across the region. Your address will not safeguard your property. **Lock Up! Every Night!**
