# Delaware State Police Investigate Fatal Hit and Run Pedestrian Crash- Newark

*Newark, DE-* Delaware State Police are investigating a fatal hit and run pedestrian crash that occurred early Saturday morning in Newark.

On December 4, 2021, at approximately 2:39 a.m., a dark colored 4-door passenger vehicle was traveling northbound in the right lane of Sunset Lake Road (SR 72) just north of the Old Baltimore Pike intersection. For unknown reasons, the 42-year-old Wilmington male was lying in the middle of the right thru lane. The passenger vehicle struck the pedestrian, continued traveling northbound on SR 72 and failed to stop.

The 42-year-old male was pronounced deceased at the scene. Identification is pending notification to next of kin.

Northbound Sunset Lake Rd (SR 72) in the vicinity of Old Baltimore Pike was closed to vehicular traffic for approximately 3 hours during the on-scene investigation.

This collision remains under investigation by the Delaware State Police Troop 2 Collision Reconstruction Unit. # Investigating Homicide-Suicide Incident- Bridgeville

**Bridgeville, DE** – Delaware State Police are investigating a homicide-suicide in the Bridgeville area that occurred Thursday night.

At approximately 10:45 p.m. on Thursday, December 2, 2021, troopers were dispatched to the 100 block of Emily's Pintail Drive for a report of a shooting.

Prior to their arrival, it was determined the homeowners, a 71-year-old male victim and his wife had returned to their residence at approximately 9:30 p.m. The female was in the first floor bathroom when she heard footsteps on the second floor, where her 58-year-old brother resides. Immediately after hearing the footsteps, she heard a loud bang. When she exited the bathroom, she discovered her husband in the family room with an apparent gunshot wound. The female ran to a neighbor's house where police were called.

Responding officers located the 71-year-old male victim deceased in the family room with an apparent gunshot wound. They then searched the residence and located the 58-year-old male suspect deceased upstairs in his bedroom with an apparent self-inflicted gunshot wound. Both men were pronounced deceased at the scene.

The bodies have been turned over to the Division of Forensic Science where an autopsy will be performed to determine the manner and cause of death.

The Delaware State Police Homicide Unit is continuing their investigation into this suspected murder/suicide incident and there is no concerns for public safety. No motive has been established for this incident.

## Arrest Made in New Castle Area Liquor Store Robbery

**New Castle** – The Delaware State Police have arrested a Middletown man after he robbed an area liquor store.

The incident began around 12:30 p.m. Wednesday December 1, 2021, when **Keith A. Turner Jr.**, 36, entered the Rambleton Acres Liquor Store, located at 135 Christiana Road, brandishing a large butcher knife. Turner confronted a store clerk and demanded money. The employee, along with another store employee, were able to run out of the business and lock the door leaving Turner inside. Once the two store clerks were

safely outside, Turner, who was now locked in the liquor store, removed an undisclosed amount of money from the cash register. Turner then attempted to escape the business by throwing a metal shopping cart at the front door and then attempted to flee out a rear bathroom window that he soon realized was too small.

With the assistance of New Castle County Police Department's K9 Unit (Thor), commands were made for Turner to exit the building or the K9 would be released. Turner complied with the instructions and surrendered without further incident.

Keith Turner was transported back to Troop 2 where he was charged with the following:

- Robbery 1st
- Possession of a Deadly Weapon During the Commission of a Felony
- Wearing a Disguise During the Commission of a Felony
- Two counts of Criminal Mischief

Turner was arraigned via videophone with JP2 and committed to Howard R. Young Correctional Institution on \$127,100.00 cash bond.

# State Police Investigating Robbery of Wilmington Area Family Dollar

**Wilmington** – Troopers are investigating a robbery of an area retail store that occurred Monday evening.

The incident occurred at approximately 9:08 p.m., Monday November 29, 2021, at Family Dollar located at 2021 Kirkwood Highway, as a male subject confronted two employees as there were standing behind the sales counter. The suspect was armed with an unknown type handgun and demanded money. The clerks complied and turned over an undisclosed amount of cash before the suspect fled out of the store and ran toward Kirkwood Highway. The store employees were not injured in the incident.

The suspect was described as a black male, 25-29 years of age, 5'09"-6'01" tall, wearing all black clothing, and had a black mask covering his face (no further physical or clothing description). He was armed with an unknown type handgun.

# Delaware State Police Investigate Fatal Collision- Smyrna

*Smyrna, DE-* Delaware State Police are investigating a two-car fatal collision that occurred on Monday in Smyrna city limits.

On November 29, 2021, at approximately 10:21 a.m., a 2012 Hyundai Santa Fe was traveling southbound on South DuPont Blvd (US 13) in the left lane approaching the traffic light at the intersection of South Carter Rd. At the same time, a 2005 Dodge Grand Caravan was traveling eastbound on S. Carter Rd. in the left turn lane approaching the green light at the intersection to travel northbound on S. DuPont Blvd. For unknown reasons, the driver of the Santa Fe failed to stop at the red light, and the front bumper struck the left driver's side door of the Caravan near the center of the intersection. After impact, the Caravan overturned onto its passenger side just east of the collision scene. The Santa Fe continued traveling southbound a short distance and came to rest southeast of the initial impact.

The driver of the Santa Fe was a 28-year-old Hartly woman. She was transported to an area hospital, where she was treated and released.

The driver of the Grand Caravan was a 51-year-old Clayton woman. She was extricated from the vehicle by fire department personnel and transported to an area hospital, where she died a short time later. Identification is pending notification to next of kin.

# Troopers Investigating Commercial Burglary- Rehoboth Beach

**Rehoboth Beach, DE-** Delaware State Police are investigating a burglary to the Sunglass Hut located in the Midway Tanger Outlets.
