State Police Arrest Employee at Senior Living Community

Bridgeville Man for Drug and DUI Offenses

Delaware State Police have arrested 24-year-old **Marcus Massey Jr.**, of Bridgeville, Delaware, for drug and DUI charges following a traffic stop in Frankford on Thursday.

On December 18, 2025, at approximately 3:20 p.m., a trooper was on patrol in the area of Cypress Swamp in Frankford. The trooper conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle that failed to maintain its lane and almost struck oncoming traffic. The driver was identified as Marcus Massey Jr. While speaking with Massey Jr., the trooper observed signs of impairment and administered Standard Field Sobriety Tests. During the investigation, a search of the suspect revealed approximately 4.29 grams of heroin concealed on his person. Additionally, a computer search revealed that Massey Jr. had three prior DUI convictions.

Massey Jr. was taken into custody without incident and transported to Troop 4, where he was charged with the crimes listed below, arraigned by the Justice of the Peace Court 2, and committed to the Sussex Correctional Institution on a \$11,503 secured bond.

- 4th Offense Driving a Vehicle Under the Influence of Any Drug (Felony)
- Possession of Controlled Substance, Tier 2 (Felony)

State Police Arrest Two for Stolen Vehicle, Drugs

The Delaware State Police have arrested 53-year-old **Lisa Savage** of Salisbury, Maryland, and 47-year-old **Lavarr Holbrook** of Seaford, Delaware, in connection with a stolen vehicle and drug offenses on Tuesday in Seaford.

On December 16, 2026, at approximately 8:15 p.m., while patrolling Concord Road, Seaford, a trooper from Troop 5 observed a 2009 Lincoln MKS that had been reported stolen by the Salisbury Police Department. After stopping the vehicle,

the trooper identified the occupants as Lisa Savage and Lavarr Holbrook and took both into custody without incident.

During a subsequent search of the vehicle and suspects, troopers located drug paraphernalia belonging to Savage, and approximately 1.53 grams of heroin and approximately 0.76 grams of crack cocaine concealed on Holbrook's person.

Savage was taken to Troop 5, where she was charged with the crimes listed below, arraigned by the Justice of the Peace Court 7, and committed to the Sussex Correctional Institution on a \$3,200 cash bond.



- Receiving Stolen Property > \$1500 (Felony)
- Possession of Drug Paraphernalia Not Related to Marijuana
- Driving Without a Valid License

Holbrook was taken to Troop 5, where he was charged with the crimes listed below, arraigned by the Justice of the Peace Court 7, and committed to the Sussex Correctional Institution on a \$4,400 cash bond.



- Manufacture/Deliver/PWID Controlled Substance (Felony)
- Possess/Consume a Controlled or Counterfeit Substance
- Possession of Drug Paraphernalia Not Related to Marijuana

State Police Investigating Home Invasion in Seaford

Delaware State Police are investigating a home invasion that occurred on Tuesday in Seaford.

On Wednesday, December 17, 2025, at approximately 1:30 p.m., troopers responded to a residence in the 25000 block of Rocky Road for a welfare check. The request was made by a concerned relative who had been unable to contact the homeowner.

When troopers arrived, they contacted the 74-year-old male resident who reported that he had been robbed the previous evening. The preliminary investigation revealed that the suspect had previously been at the residence earlier in the day. At approximately 6:00 p.m., the same suspect returned to

the home accompanied by three additional male suspects. The four suspects forced their way into the residence, and one of them displayed a firearm.

Once inside, the suspects demanded money and other personal items. During the incident, one of the suspects struck the victim on the top of the head. The suspects then fled the residence on foot. The victim sustained minor injuries.

The suspects are described as four black males. Three of the suspects were wearing masks. No additional suspect description is available at this time.

Troop 4 Criminal Investigations Unit continues to investigate this incident. Multi-Agency Investigation Leads to Arrest of Maryland Man Following Pursuit, Ending Nearly Two-Year Burglary Spree

The Delaware State Police arrested 42-year-old **Keeno Exum**, from Elkton, Maryland, in connection with multiple burglaries

spanning almost two years.

From January 2024 through December 2025, the Delaware State Police Property Crimes Unit investigated 26 burglaries involving a suspect with similar appearance or pattern of behavior in each incident. Investigators learned the suspect typically wore similar clothing and a black mask and often targeted Asian or Hispanic restaurants between 4:30 a.m. and 7:00 a.m. Investigators discovered the suspect would either use a prybar to force open a door or throw a hard object through the business's glass to gain access. Once inside, the suspect ransacked offices and cash registers before escaping on foot with stolen money.

Detectives learned the same suspect targeted multiple businesses in surrounding jurisdictions, including Middletown, Delaware. Through joint investigative efforts, State Police Detectives and Middletown Police Detectives identified Exum as the suspect from all incidents and found out he drove multiple vehicles, including a Toyota Camry.

On December 15, 2025, at approximately 6:15 a.m., troopers saw Exum driving the Camry on Old Capitol Trail, near St. James Church Road, in Wilmington. Troopers attempted to stop the Camry on Kirkwood Highway, near Delaware Park Drive, however Exum drove away at a high rate of speed. Troopers pursued Exum, however the pursuit was discontinued shortly after entering Pennsylvania. Investigators watched the Camry from a safe distance until it stopped at an apartment in the 800 Block of Clear Blossom Drive, in Elkton, Maryland.

Detectives requested assistance from the Elkton Police Department, who obtained a search warrant for the apartment. At approximately 11:00 a.m., the warrant was executed and Exum attempted to escape by jumping from a second story window. Exum was taken into custody. A search of the apartment revealed clothing and other items detectives believe Exum used during the burglaries.

Exum was held in the Cecil County Detention Center, in Maryland, before being extradited to Troop 2. On December 16, 2025, Exum was charged with the below offenses, arraigned by Justice of the Peace Court 11, and committed to the Howard R. Young Correctional Institution on a \$321,611.00 cash bond.

State Police Arrest Smyrna Man on 5th DUI Offense

The Delaware State Police arrested 62-year-old **Bryan Debello**, of Smyrna, Delaware, for a fifth-offense felony DUI and related traffic charges Monday night in Dover.

On December 15, 2025, at approximately 11:30 p.m., troopers were dispatched to the area of Fast Landing Road and East Denneys Road, in Dover, for a report of a disabled vehicle in the roadway. Troopers located a Dodge Grand Caravan stopped in the middle of the road. Troopers spoke with the driver, later identified as Debello, who thought he was parked at a boat ramp. Debello showed signs of impairment, and his license was suspended, so he was taken into custody and driven to Troop 9,

where he continued to display signs of impairment. A computer search showed Debello had four prior DUI convictions.

Debello was charged with the below offenses, arraigned by Justice of the Peace Court 7, and released on a \$6,051.00 unsecured bond.

- 5th Offense DUI (Felony)
- Driving While Suspended or Revoked
- No Person Shall Stop, Park, or Leave Standing any Vehicle Upon a Roadway

State Police Detectives Arrest Lewes Man for Attempted Murder

The Delaware State Police have arrested 31-year-old **Shane Windell** of Lewes, Delaware, for attempted murder and related charges following an incident at a residence in Lewes that left a woman critically injured.

On December 13, 2025, at approximately 3:10 a.m., troopers responded to a residence on the 33000 block of Tidal Way in Lewes for a check the welfare. When troopers arrived, they found a woman suffering from life-threatening physical injuries and a man, identified as Shane Windell, with serious lacerations. Troopers provided medical aid to the victim and Windell until EMS arrived, and both were taken to an area hospital. Due to the nature of the incident, Delaware State Police Troop 4 Criminal Investigations Unit assumed the investigation. The investigation revealed that during an argument, Windell, who is known by the victim, repeatedly

assaulted her and prevented her from leaving. It was learned that during the incident, Windell caused serious injuries to himself.

While being treated for his injuries, Windell was found to be in violation of his probation and was remanded to the custody of the Department of Corrections. On December 15, 2025, he was released from the hospital, charged with the crimes listed below, arraigned by Justice of the Peace Court 2, and committed to Sussex Correctional Institution on a \$1,041,000 cash bond.

- Attempt to Commit Murder 1st Degree (Felony)
- Kidnapping First Degree, Terrorize Victim, or a Third Person – No Release (Felony)
- Strangulation or Suffocation – Causes Serious Physical Injury to Another Person (Felony)
- Terroristic Threatening

State Police Arrest Three Teens in Possession of Stolen Vehicle After Crash

The Delaware State Police arrested a 14-year-old, a 15-year-old, and a 16-year-old from Wilmington, Delaware, after they crashed a stolen SUV and ran from troopers Sunday afternoon.

On December 14, 2025, at approximately 12:00 p.m., the Delaware State Police dispatch center shared updated information about a Ford Explorer, which was reported stolen by the New Castle County Police Department the day prior. A trooper was patrolling on Kirkwood Highway, near Poplar Avenue in Elsmere, when they saw the stolen Explorer traveling eastbound on Kirkwood Highway. The trooper followed the Explorer on several area streets while waiting for additional law enforcement support.

Troopers saw the Explorer run a red light as it traveled southbound on North Dupont Road, crossing North Maryland Avenue, then crash into a Dodge Ram pickup truck on South Dupont Road, in Wilmington. The 14-year-old driver and the 15-year-old passenger ran away, and after a brief foot chase, they were apprehended without further incident. The 16-year-old passenger stayed at the Explorer and was taken into custody without incident.

The driver of the Dodge, a 62-year-old man from Newark, Delaware, was taken to an area hospital with non-life-threatening injuries.

None of the teenage boys reported any injuries on scene.

and committed to the Department of Services for Children, Youth, and Their Families on a \$3,700 secured bond.
