Delaware State Police Investigating Fatal Motorcycle Crash- Dover

Dover – The Delaware State Police Collision Reconstruction Unit is conducting an investigation into a fatal motorcycle crash on Forrest Avenue (Route 8) that occurred Friday night.

The incident occurred at approximately 8:18 p.m., on Friday, August 6, 2021, when a white 2008 Ford Edge was eastbound on Forrest Avenue (Route 8) preparing to make a left turn into Route 8 Liquor complex. A 2017 Harley Davidson motorcycle was westbound on Forest Avenue approaching the Ford. The Ford waited for an uninvolved vehicle in front of the Harley to pass westbound, and then proceeded to make his left turn directly into the path of the Harley. The 74-year-old operator

of the Harley attempted to brake the motorcycle, but was unable to avoid the collision. The front of the Harley struck the passenger side of the Ford. The operator was ejected from the motorcycle and came to rest in the westbound travel lane.

The 74-year-old operator of the Harley was transported to Bayhealth-Kent Campus where he was pronounced deceased. Identification is pending notification to the next of kin.

The 46-year-old male operator of the Ford was not injured during the collision.

No charges have been filed at this time as the investigation remains on-going.

The crash remains under investigation by the Delaware State Police Troop 3 Collision Reconstruction Unit. Delaware State Police Investigating Fatal Motor Vehicle Collision- Middletown

Middletown- Delaware State Police are investigating a fatal motor vehicle collision that occurred Friday morning on northbound Route 1 at Pole Bridge Road.

On August 06, 2021, at approximately 2:18 a.m., a gray 2006 Nissan Pathfinder, operator undetermined at this time, was traveling northbound on Route 1. For reasons unknown the Pathfinder entered the grass median and struck the cable barrier. The pathfinder then began traveling eastbound across the northbound lanes of Route 1 and up a grass embankment until reentering the roadway a second time. The Pathfinder then traveled westbound across the northbound lanes of Route 1 lanes and directly into the path of a 2018 Freightliner tractor trailer, operated by a 50-year-old male. After this collision the Pathfinder became disabled in the roadway. At this time, a 2013 Chevrolet Malibu, operated by a 75-year-old female was traveling northbound on Route 1 approaching the area of Pole Bridge Road. The Malibu was unable to avoid colliding with the Pathfinder and the front of the Malibu struck the Pathfinder. As a result of the collision the Malibu

came to a rest in the center grass median and the Pathfinder came to a rest facing in a northeast direction still in the roadway. A 2012 Subaru Outback, operated by a 79-year-old female was traveling northbound on Route 1 approaching the area of Pole Bridge Road. The Outback was unable to avoid colliding with the Pathfinder and the front of the Outback struck the rear right corner of the Pathfinder.

There were two occupants, a 54-year-old female and a 54-year-old male inside of the Pathfinder. Both occupants were not properly restrained, and both were located outside of the vehicle prior to police arrival. The female occupant of the Pathfinder was pronounced deceased at the scene of the collision. Identification is pending notification to the next of kin. The male occupant was transported to Christiana Hospital in critical condition.

The operator of the Malibu was wearing her seatbelt and her airbags deployed. She was treated and released from Christiana Hospital after being treated for minor injuries.

The operator of the Outback was wearing her seatbelt and her airbags deployed. She was transported to Christiana Hospital in critical condition.

Impairment on the part of the occupants of Pathfinder at this time is pending. Due to both occupants being located outside of the vehicle prior to police arrival it is unknown who the operator is at this time. The circumstances to this collision are still being investigated and on-going.

Traffic traveling northbound on SR 1 was diverted onto Exit 142 and re-entered the highway north of the collision scene.

The investigation remains on-going. State Police Investigating Serious Crash- Middletown

Middletown – Delaware State Police are on the scene of a serious motor vehicle crash that occurred at approximately 2:18 a.m., Friday, August 6, 2021, on Route 1 in the area of Pole Bridge Road.
