Troopers Arrest Seaford Man After Investigation Leads to the Discovery of Weapons and Explosive Devices- Millsboro

Millsboro- Delaware State Police arrested 22-year-old **Joshua Allen Rieley** of Seaford after an investigation leads to the discovery of weapons and explosive devices.

On March 24, 2021, Delaware State Police responded to a residence on Hollyville Road, Millsboro, for a reported drug complaint. Through the investigation, glass bottles were discovered in a shed filled with an unknown substance, and the bottles were possibly Molotov Cocktails. The Delaware State Fire Marshals Office, Delaware State Police Bomb Unit, and Delaware Department of Natural Resources and Environmental

Control responded to the scene. Delaware State Fire Marshals Office assumed the investigation for the incendiary devices. A search warrant was executed on the shed, and the following items were discovered inside:

- Military Gear
- Materials to make explosives
- .22 assault-style rifle with an obliterated serial number
- ManKung crossbow

Rieley was taken into custody without incident and transported to Troop 4, where he was charged with the following crimes:

- Possession of a Firearm by a Person Prohibited (Felony)
- Possession of a Destructive Weapon by a Person Prohibited (Felony)
- Possession of a Firearm with an Obliterated Serial Number (Felony)

Rieley was arraigned in the Justice of the Peace Court #3 and committed to Sussex Correctional Institution on a \$35,000.00 secured bond on the above charges.

The Delaware State Fire Marshalls Office is the investigating agency dealing with the explosive devices.

Delaware State Police Investigating Armed Robbery of Tobacco Shop- Wilmington

Wilmington- Delaware State Police are investigating an armed robbery of a tobacco shop that occurred late Wednesday afternoon.

On March 24, 2021, at approximately 4:21 p.m., troopers were dispatched to the Smoke Shop located at 1706 Kirkwood Highway for a robbery. The investigation determined a male suspect entered the business and approached an employee working behind the sales counter. The suspect displayed a black handgun towards the employee and demanded all the money. The employee complied and the suspect fled the store on foot with an undisclosed amount of cash. No one was injured during the incident, and no surveillance footage or pictures are available at this time.

The suspect was described as a black male, approximately 5'7"- 5'9" tall, weighing 160-175 lbs., and wearing all dark clothing with a black face mask.

***Update #1* Delaware State
Police Investigating Fatal**

Motor Vehicle Collision- Bear

Bear- Delaware State Police are investigating a multiple vehicle collision that occurred Tuesday morning on Pulaski Highway (Route 40) at the intersection with Buckley Boulevard.

On March 23, 2021, at approximately 11:24 a.m., a 2014 Toyota RAV4 was traveling westbound on Pulaski Highway (Route 40) in the right lane of travel. The Toyota came to a stop at the intersection of Buckley Boulevard for a red traffic signal and was the first vehicle stopped in the right lane. A 2005 Ford Freestyle was traveling westbound on Route 40 and stopped directly behind the Toyota. A 2009 Chevrolet Cobalt was traveling westbound on Route 40 in the right lane of travel approaching the intersection. The Chevrolet failed to stop, and the front of the Cobalt struck the rear of the Ford. After the initial collision, the Ford was pushed forward and struck the rear of the Toyota.

The Toyota came to a controlled stop on the right shoulder of westbound Route 40 just west of the intersection. The Ford came to an uncontrolled stop in a ditch on the north side of the roadway, approximately 200 feet west of the intersection. The Cobalt came to rest in the intersection.

The operator of the 2014 Toyota RAV4 was a 63-year-old male of Wilmington. He refused medical treatment at the scene.

The operator of the 2005 Ford Freestyle was an 84-year-old female of Wilmington. She was transported by ambulance to an area hospital, where she was admitted for medical attention.

The operator of the 2009 Chevrolet Cobalt was a 72-year-old male of Elkton, Maryland. He was not wearing a seatbelt at the time of the collision. He was transported to an area hospital by ambulance, where he was pronounced deceased. Identification is pending notification to next of kin.

This collision remains under investigation by the Delaware State Police Collision Reconstruction Unit. Delaware State Police Conducting Fatal Motorcycle Crash- Newark

Newark- Delaware State Police are conducting a fatal motorcycle crash that claimed a Dover man's life.

On March 23, 2021, at approximately 5:27 p.m., a 2006 Suzuki GSX-R1000 was traveling on Otts Chapel Road in the left lane approaching North Hunter Forge Road. The 21-year-old male operator lost control of the motorcycle and began to travel to the right side of the roadway. The Suzuki then went down on its left side and slid into the concrete curb located on the northeast corner of the Otts Chapel Road and North Hunger Forge Road intersection. The operator came to rest in the left lane of Otts Chapel Road. After the motorcycle struck the curb, it hit a guardrail and was launched into the air before coming to rest approximately 100 feet north of the impact.

The operator was pronounced deceased at the scene. Identification is pending notification to next of kin.

This crash is being investigated by the Delaware State Police Collision Reconstruction Unit.
