Troopers Investigating Triple

Shooting on Governor Printz Blvd. – Wilmington

Wilmington– Delaware State Police are investigating a triple shooting that occurred on Governor Printz Blvd. in Wilmington, Wednesday evening.

At approximately 5:39 p.m., Wednesday, September 23, 2020, Troopers responded to the 4800 block of Governor Printz Blvd. in Wilmington, for a shooting that involved three victims. Upon arrival, three males ages 21, 19, and 17 were located with single gunshot wounds. The males were subsequently transported to an area hospital where they were being treated for non-life threatening injuries.

The initial investigation determined the three male victims were in front of the Bella Italy restaurant located inside of a strip mall, when two suspects standing at the North end of the strip mall began firing numerous rounds at them. The three male victims were all shot one time. Two victims were wounded in their lower extremities and one in the upper torso.

Two vehicles were struck and the glass door to Bella Italy was shattered from gunfire.

The suspects fled the scene on foot behind the strip mall. There is no suspect information at this time.

Troopers Warn Public About Leaving Cars Unattended While Idling

New Castle County- The Delaware State Police would like to warn the public about leaving their cars unattended while idling.

The Delaware State Police, Troop 2 Property Crimes Unit has recently been handling a rash of vehicle thefts occurring in the New Castle County area. A large majority of the thefts have occurred from gas stations in which a vehicle was left unattended, idling, and unlocked.

The most common practice is a victim leaving their car running in a parking lot while they go into a store for a quick

purchase. Some car thieves look for cars idling in parking lots and once they see a car is left unattended, all they have to do is walk up and drive away.

Delaware law states; **(Title 21, § 4182) Unattended motor vehicle.** No person driving or in charge of a motor vehicle shall permit it to stand unattended without first stopping the engine, locking the ignition, removing the key and effectively setting the brake thereon and, when standing upon any grade, turning the front wheels to the curb or side of the highway. For a first offense, a fine of \$25.00 – \$75.00 can be imposed.

The suspects in these most recent cases appear to be juvenile males. Delaware State Police Investigating Fatal Crash Involving Motorcycle- Newark

Newark– Delaware State Police are investigating a fatal motor vehicle crash involving a motorcycle that occurred at approximately 10:14 p.m., Wednesday, September 23, 2020, on Fashion Center Boulevard.

The initial investigation has determined a Suzuki GSXR 750 operated by a 16 year-old male from Newark, DE, was stopped in the fire lane facing east in front of REI Sporting Goods store located at 2300 Fashion Center Blvd. A 2008 Infiniti G35 began racing westbound in the fire lane and was approaching the Suzuki at a high rate of speed. The front of the Infiniti struck the front of the motorcycle and ejected the 16 year-old operator and his 17 year-old female passenger.

The operator of Suzuki was transported to Christiana Hospital where he was pronounced deceased. His name is being withheld at this time pending the notification of next of kin.

The female passenger on the Suzuki was transported to Christiana Hospital and treated for non-life threatening injuries.

The operator of the Infiniti, a 20 year-old male from Newark initially fled on foot, but was later taken into custody at the Christiana Hospital. The 20 year-old male who was not wearing a seatbelt was treated at the hospital for non-life threatening injuries.

The Troop 2 Collision Reconstruction Unit continues to

investigate the crash, charges are pending the outcome of the investigation.

“I-95 Drive to Save Lives” and “Drive to Save Lives in Delaware” Traffic Initiatives Friday, October 2nd and Saturday October 3rd, 2020

The Delaware State Police in partnership with the Delaware Office of Highway Safety are joining forces with other law enforcement agencies along the I-95 corridor and across the State of Delaware in the “Drive to Save Lives- October 2020” campaign. This campaign is a multi-jurisdictional, high-visibility traffic enforcement initiative that is meant to increase traffic enforcement presence and efforts along the I-95 corridor from Maine to Florida and across the State of Delaware on Friday, October 2nd and Saturday, October 3rd, 2020. The Delaware State Police (DSP) will be the lead agency for this campaign by coordinating the efforts of the other 14 State Police and Highway Patrol agencies along I-95, as well as the 24 participating Delaware law enforcement agencies in order to increase the totality of law enforcement presence over this 48-hour period.

The “Drive to Save Lives” campaign will consist of two simultaneous efforts, “I-95 Drive to Save Lives”, which will involve a total of 15 State Police and Highway Patrol agencies handling their portion of I-95, and “Drive to Save Lives in Delaware”, which will entail 24 participating Delaware agencies patrolling their own jurisdictions.



Interstate 95 (I-95) is approximately 1,920 miles in length, while Delaware in its entire length is only 96 miles. This initiative will cover a large majority of the roadway. This will also be a contributing effort to support the International Association of Chiefs of Police (IACP) initiative, “The Drive to Save Lives Campaign” and its goal to reduce traffic deaths and injuries across the U.S. Crash-related data and information from various sources, such as NHTSA, FARS and the National Safety Council provide the rationale for this campaign. Likewise, the emphasis of this initiative will be to change the high-risk behaviors of motorists, such as distracted driving, impaired driving, speeding, unsafe driving behaviors of the operators of large trucks/buses and the failure of motorists and passengers alike to wear seat-belts. Lastly, the initiative will include the goal of having no fatalities all along I-95, or within Delaware during the weekend.

On October 2nd and 3rd all of Delaware’s citizens and visitors can expect to see multiple agencies working diligently to keep them safe as they travel throughout the state; therefore, drive to save lives.

Troopers Investigating Robbery of Gas Station - Newark

Newark – The Delaware State Police are investigating the robbery of a Newark area gas station that occurred early this morning.

A male suspect confronted an employee at the sales counter while displaying a handgun, and demanded money from inside of the register. Delaware State Police Arrest Smyrna Man on Felony Criminal Charges - Smyrna

Smyrna- Delaware State Police arrested 69-year-old **Elliott Glover** of Smyrna on felony criminal charges.

On Saturday, September 19, 2020, at approximately 1:07 p.m., Delaware State Police and Smyrna Fire Department responded to

a disabled vehicle stuck in the water on Woodland Beach Road, Smyrna. During their investigation, troopers learned the 33-year-old male victim received a phone call from a family member advising they were in their vehicle stuck in the water. The victim attempted to drive out to the location to assist his family when he was stopped on Woodland Beach Road by Glover, who is a member of the Smyrna Fire Department and was on the scene as Fire Police to assist with traffic control. The victim communicated with Glover about what he was doing, and Glover refused to allow him through. While still stopped, the victim cut the wheels of his vehicle to the right as if he was going to drive around Glover. Glover then reached behind his back and drew a black handgun, pointed it at him, and said he was going to shoot him. The victim and Glover had an exchange of words before the victim left the area. No one was injured during the incident.

Glover responded to Troop 9, where he was charged with the following crimes:

- Aggravated Menacing (Felony)
- Possession of a Deadly Weapon During the Commission of a Felony (Felony)

Glover was arraigned in Justice of the Peace Court #7 and released on a \$10,000 unsecured bond.
