

Troopers Seek Public's Assistance in Locating Suspect Wanted For Aggravated Menacing-Dover

Dover- The Delaware State Police are seeking the public's assistance in attempting to locate 37-year-old **KEVIN W. JONES** of Dover, who is wanted for aggravated menacing.

The incident occurred on June 6, 2020 at approximately 12:30 a.m., when Jones drove his girlfriend and her friend to a residence in Dover. The two females exited the vehicle and entered the residence. Jones proceeded to leave the area with the two females' purses that were left inside the vehicle.

The females made arrangements to meet with Jones at the Royal Farms, located at 6 W. Lebanon Road, Dover, to retrieve their purses. While one of the female's was grabbing her purse, Jones was in possession of a firearm and pointed at her. Both females were able to get their purses back, when they discovered that an undisclosed amount of cash had been stolen. The two female victims, ages 28 and 37 did not sustain injury as a result of this incident.

Troopers have been unable to locate Jones who currently has an active warrant out of Troop 3 for the following:

- Aggravated Menacing (Felony)
- Theft Under \$1500 (2 counts)

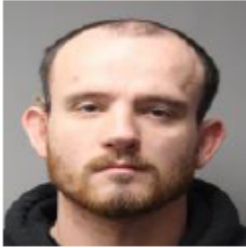

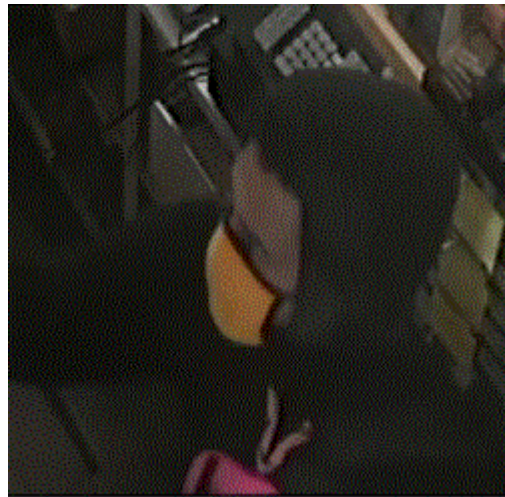
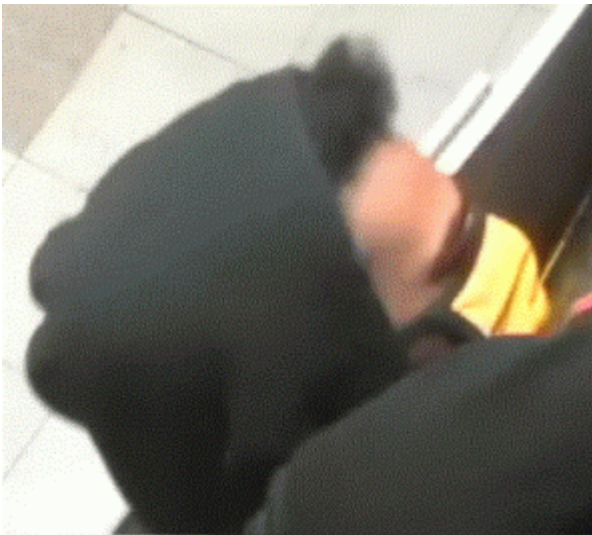

Troopers Attempt to Identify Burglary Suspect- Wilmington



Wilmington- The Delaware State Police are attempting to identify the suspect involved in a burglary, which occurred at Plaza Liquors located at 1600 West Newport Pike, Wilmington.

On June 1, 2020, at approximately 1:40 a.m., an unknown suspect used a rock to shatter the front glass window of the

business then gained entry. Once inside, the suspect removed property before fleeing through the front door and traveling northbound towards DE 4.

The suspect is a thin light-skinned black or Hispanic male wearing a dark-colored hooded sweatshirt and dark-colored pants (possibly blue), white socks, and red sneakers. The suspect is wearing an orange mask and had a pink and black colored (2 shoulder strap) backpack.

***UPDATE* Troopers Investigating Serious Crash on Pulaski Hwy (Rt 40) - Newark**

Newark- The Delaware State Police are investigating a crash involving two vehicles that occurred on June 3, 2020 at 3:56 p.m. on Pulaski Highway (US 40) at Pleasant Valley Road.

The investigation revealed a gray 2009 Ford Escape operated by an 18-year-old female was turning left onto Pleasant Valley Road from eastbound Pulaski Highway (US 40). A silver Mazda 3 operated by a 29-year-old man from Elkton, MD was traveling westbound on Pulaski Highway (US 40). The Ford Escape had a green arrow and entered the intersection. The Mazda 3 passed stopped cars on westbound Pulaski Highway, disregarding the red light, entered the intersection and struck the Ford Escape. After the crash, the vehicles came to rest in the

intersection with the Ford Escape rolling onto its driver's side. The operator of the Mazda 3 was transported to a local area hospital where he was pronounced deceased as a result of injuries not related to the accident.

The operator of the Ford Escape and two additional occupants, an 18 year old female from Camden-Wyoming and a 16- year-old female from Middletown were transported to a local hospital where they were treated and released.

Delaware State Police Arrest Individuals for Looting-Wilmington

Wilmington— The Delaware State Police responded to Walmart at 1251 Centerville Road, Wilmington, for looting reports.

Upon arrival, Troopers took five subjects into custody in or about the store. The investigation revealed, 26-year-old **Lamont Davis** of Wilmington, gained access to the store by shattering the front glass with a baseball bat and ramming a shopping cart into the glass doors. Once inside, Davis removed property without rendering payment and exited the store. At the same time, 31-year-old **Traci Roane** of Wilmington, 13-year-old **Aulyiah Brown** of Wilmington, 13-year-old **Ahjr Black** of Wilmington, and 14-year-old **Jaidah Matthews** of Wilmington, entered the store and removed an undisclosed amount of property from displays and attempted to exit the store with same. All property was recovered at the scene and

returned to the store. The total damage sustained by the business was estimated to be over \$2,000.00.

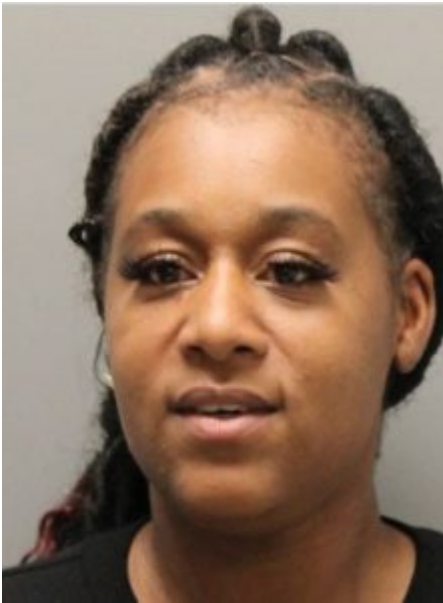

Davis was arraigned by Justice of the Peace Court and issued a \$5,000.00 unsecured bond.

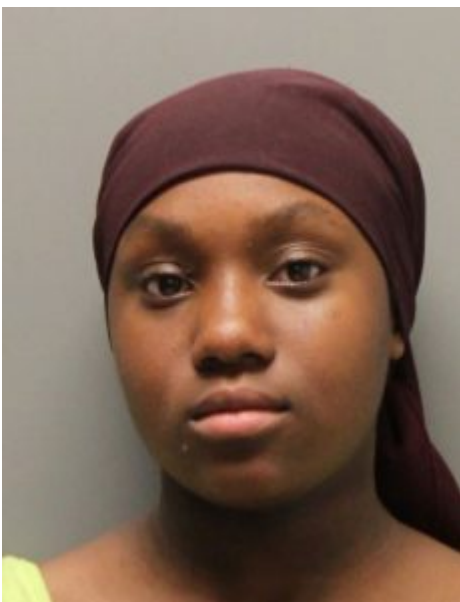

Brown was arraigned by Justice of the Peace Court and Released on Own Recognize.

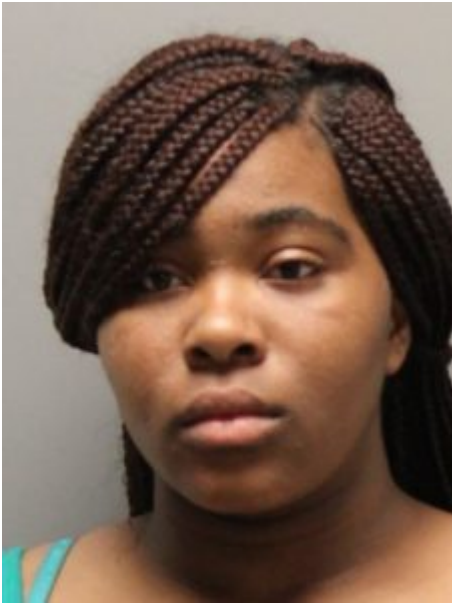

***UPDATE* Troopers Investigating Fatal Motorcycle Crash Dyke Branch Rd at Bayside Dr (SR. 9) - Dover**

Dover – The Delaware State Police are investigating a fatal crash involving a motorcycle and vehicle that occurred at approximately 3:17 p.m., Sunday, May 31, 2020. The crash happened at the intersection of Bayside Drive (SR 9) and Dyke Branch Road, Dover.

The initial investigation has determined a 1992 Harley Davidson FLF motorcycle operated by a 49-year-old Wilmington man, was traveling northbound on Bayside Drive (SR 9) toward

Dyke Branch Road. A 2013 Ford Edge operated by a 47-year-old Dover, woman, was traveling northbound on Bayside Drive in front of the motorcycle, preparing to make a left turn onto Dyke Branch Road. As the Ford Edge began to turn left, the motorcycle attempted to pass the vehicle in a no-passing zone on the left side. The operator of the motorcycle attempted to avoid the collision but was unable, and the front right collided with the left front fender of the Ford Edge, which resulted in the operator being ejected from the motorcycle. The motorcycle and the operator continued traveling in a northerly direction and came to rest in the ditch north of the collision scene. The Ford Edge came to rest in the approximate location of the collision.

The operator of the motorcycle was transported to a nearby hospital where he succumbed to his injuries.

The operator of the Ford Edge was treated at the scene and released.

The identification of the victim is pending notification to next of kin.
