

UPDATE **Troopers** **Investigating** **Fatal** **Motorcycle Crash, I-95 at** **Martin Luther King Blvd. –** **Wilmington**

Wilmington – The Delaware State Police are continuing to investigate a fatal crash involving a motorcycle that occurred at approximately 11:21 a.m., Monday, May 4, 2020 on the northbound I-95 on ramp from MLK Jr. Blvd., in the area of W. 2nd St., Wilmington.

The initial investigation has determined that a 2009 Yamaha R6, operated by a 27 year old Wilmington man, was traveling west on the on ramp from MLK Jr. Blvd., to proceed northbound on I-95. As the Yamaha approached a sharp right curve it failed to remain in the lane and veered left, striking a concrete barrier. Upon impact the operator was ejected off the motorcycle and thrown over the barrier, coming to rest in a surface parking lot approximately 50 feet below the elevated roadway, where he was pronounced deceased.

Identification of the victim is pending notification of next of kin.

The on-ramp from MLK Jr. Blvd to I-95 was closed for approximately 1 hour 45 minutes while the scene was investigated and cleared.

Troopers Investigating Robbery of New Castle Pharmacy

New Castle – The Delaware State Police are investigating the robbery of a New Castle area pharmacy that occurred Sunday night.

The incident occurred at approximately 8:16 p.m., Sunday, May 3, 2020 at the Rite Aid pharmacy, located at 2034 New Castle Avenue. A male suspect approached an employee at the sales counter, implied that he was armed with firearm and demanded cash from the register. The employee turned over an undisclosed amount of cash to the suspect who then fled on foot. No weapon was displayed, only implied. The employee was not injured as a result of the incident.

The suspect was described as a black male, 5'10"-6'1" tall, 185-200 lbs., wearing all dark clothing to include a fabric concealing his face.

***UPDATE* Troopers
Investigating Serious Crash
at Intersection of Lighthouse
Rd. and Salty Way Dr. -**

Selbyville

Selbyville – The Delaware State Police are investigating a serious crash involving a bicyclist that occurred at approximately 1:52 p.m., Saturday, May 3, 2020, at the intersection of Lighthouse Rd. and Salty Way Drive, Selbyville.

The initial investigation has determined a 1997 Nissan pickup truck, operated by a 30-year-old Frankford man, was traveling eastbound on Lighthouse Road, approaching Salty Way. A 69-year-old Selbyville woman, who was riding a bicycle, traveling eastbound on Lighthouse Road, within the designated westbound bicycle lane, for unknown reasons crossed over Lighthouse Road directly into the path of the Nissan pickup truck. The operator of the pickup truck was unable to avoid the collision, and the left front of the vehicle collided with the right side of the bicycle within the eastbound lane of Lighthouse Road. After the impact, the operator of the Nissan pickup truck came to a controlled stop and within the eastbound travel lane.

The bicyclist was transported to the Christiana Hospital with serious injuries.

The driver of the Nissan pickup truck was not injured.

The eastbound travel lane of Lighthouse Road was closed for approximately 3.0 hours while the crash was investigated and cleared.

Traffic Stop Leads to Drug Arrests - Rehoboth Beach

Rehoboth Beach- The Delaware State Police have arrested three suspects after a traffic stop led to the discovery of drugs.

The incident occurred on Friday, May 1, 2020, at approximately 10:48 a.m., when a Trooper observed a light blue Jeep Cherokee fail to stop at a stop sign on Holland Glade Road at Coastal Highway. A traffic stop was initiated, and contact was made with the occupants of the vehicle, operator, **30-year-old Zachary Caras** and passengers, **48-year-old Anthony Didomenicis**, and **35-year-old Suzanne Talbot**, all from Lewes. Through

investigative measures and numerous criminal indicators observed during the traffic stop, the occupants were asked to exit the vehicle. Located in Caras' right front pocket and the vehicle was drug paraphernalia. Drug paraphernalia was also located in a bag Talbot had in her possession with two bundles of heroin concealed on her person inside her clothing. Located in Didomenicis' right cargo pocket were two bundles of heroin, drug paraphernalia, and \$1,164.00 USC suspected of being proceeds from drug sales. A total of approximately .42 grams of heroin was seized from the traffic stop.

Caras, Didomenicis, and Talbot were transported to Troop 7, where they were each charged and arraigned by Justice of the Peace Court.

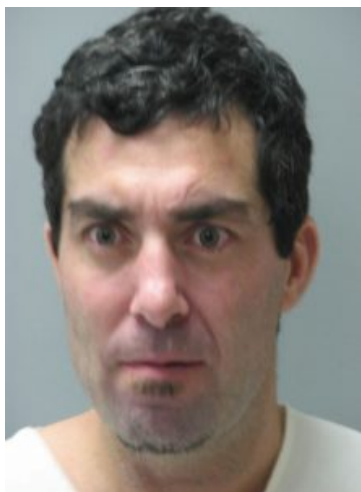
Caras was charged with the following crimes and released on a \$2,801.00 unsecured bond.

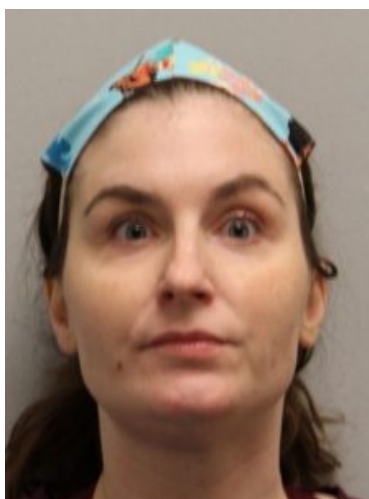

Wilmington Man Arrested After Crashing Into Residence-Millsboro

Millsboro— The Delaware State Police have arrested a Wilmington man for his 3rd Offense Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol after he crashed his vehicle into a residence.

The incident occurred on Friday, May 1, 2020, at approximately 8:15 p.m., when Troopers were dispatched to East Wind Drive, Millsboro, for a red Mercedes Benz that crashed into a residence. Upon arrival, Troopers made contact with the driver, 54-year-old John S. Ruello, and an odor of alcohol was detected, which led to a DUI investigation.

The investigation revealed Ruello was traveling southbound on Long Neck Road, and for unknown reasons he crossed the center line. The vehicle traveled off the roadway to the left, over an embankment and eventually struck a residence on East Wind Drive. The impact of the front center of Ruello's vehicle striking the deck of the residence, caused the deck to collapse and damage a vehicle parked in the driveway. Ruello was transported to Beebe Hospital for a laceration to his head.

Ruello was charged with the following:

- 3rd Offense Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol
- Failure to Drive in Proper Lane and Direction

He was arraigned before the Justice of the Peace Court and issued \$2,001.00 bond.

Traffic Stop Leads to Arrest of Smyrna Man for Theft of Construction Materials-

Millsboro/Lewes

Millsboro/Lewes- The Delaware State Police have arrested Michael Irwin, 45, of Smyrna, DE, in connection with multiple thefts from construction sites.

Since the end of April 2020, Troopers began investigating reports of thefts from construction sites in developments under construction in the Millsboro and Lewes area.

On April 29, 2020, at approximately 11:20 p.m., Troopers were on routine patrol in the area of Tributary Boulevard, Millsboro, when they observed a black Ford Ranger pulling a trailer traveling with no lights on. A traffic stop was conducted, and contact was made with the operator who was identified as Irwin. Through further investigation, Troopers determined Irwin was driving under the influence of alcohol and was taken into custody. In clear view in the bed of the trailer, Troopers observed construction packaging that were consistent with materials that have been reported stolen. It was determined through investigative measures the property in Irwin's possession was stolen.

Irwin was transported to Troop 4 where he was processed and charged with the following crimes:

- 3rd Offense DUI (felony)
- Improper Lights
- Driving While Suspended
- Failure to have Insurance in Possession
- Failure to have Registration in Possession
- Theft over \$1500.00
- Theft under \$1500.00
- Trespass 3rd Degree (2 counts)
- Failure to Obey an Emergency Order

He was arraigned before Justice of the Peace Court and was committed to Sussex Correctional Institution on \$2,503.00.

Detectives with Troop 4 Criminal Investigations Unit (CIU) continue to investigate this case, and additional charges could be filed against Irwin pending the result of their investigation.
