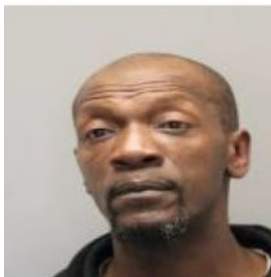

## Troopers Arrest Milford Man for 4th DUI – Rehoboth Beach

*Rehoboth Beach, DE* – Delaware State Police have arrested a Milford man after it was determined he was driving under the influence for the 4<sup>th</sup> time. The incident occurred at approximately 12:30 a.m., Friday, March 6, 2019, as a Trooper out of Troop 7, observed a white, Chevrolet Impala speeding while traveling southbound on Coastal Highway, in the area of Old Landing Rd, Rehoboth Beach.

Upon making contact with the operator, who was identified as **Marc White 52, of Milford**, a strong odor of alcohol was detected, which furthered a DUI investigation.

A computer check revealed White had 3 prior DUI convictions, making this his 4th offense. White was subsequently arrested and transported back to Troop 7 where he was charged with the following:

- 4<sup>th</sup> Offense Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol (Felony)
- Failure To Have Proof of Insurance
- Speed in Excess of Posted Limits

White was arraigned in Justice of the Peace Court #3 and then committed to the Sussex Correctional Institution in lieu of \$6,150.00 cash bail.

# **Delaware State Police Troop 3 Presents 2019 “Year in Review” to the Communities We Serve**

*Camden, Delaware* – The Delaware State Police Troop 3 Administration, led by Captain Rodney Layfield conducted a “Year in Review” in the Corporal David B. Pulling Memorial Community Room, located at 3759 South State Street, Camden, Delaware.

The Administration at Troop 3 was privileged to host a meeting where the public was provided with an overview of the great

work done by the men and women of Troop 3 in 2019. The central conversation focused on the State Police functions, duties and responsibilities Troopers handle on a daily basis. Also discussed were rates of crimes, crashes and investigative clearances in Troop 3's jurisdiction in addition to their community outreach initiatives.

Troop 3 achieved a 70% clearance rate in robberies, a 47.8% clearance rate in burglaries, and a 51.5% clearance rate in thefts. These clearance rates simply exemplify the exceptional work the Troopers are doing and demonstrate their desire to solve crimes when they occur. When examining collisions, the overall total of crashes decreased by 3.3%, and a decline in fatal crashes by 18.2%.

# **\*Traffic Advisory\* Overturned Tractor Trailer Causes Lane Closures – SR-1 Dover**

*Dover, Delaware* – The Delaware State Police are currently investigating a crash that occurred at approximately 11:50 a.m. on March 5, 2020, involving an overturned 2017 tractor-trailer and a 2009 Nissan Frontier pick-up truck. As of 2:15 a.m. this morning, SR-1 southbound south of Exit 104 is still closed due to the overturned tractor-trailer. DelDOT will remain on the scene until it is uprighted and the southbound lanes are open.

The cause of the crash is still being investigated, but preliminary investigation suggests a pick-up truck was stopped in the right travel lane of SR-1 southbound when the tractor-trailer struck it from behind. The tractor-trailer driver refused treatment. The pick-up truck driver was transported to Bayhealth Kent General with non-life-threatening injuries.

Motorists will experience delays in the area and are advised to seek alternate routes of travel.

# State Police Investigating Fatal Industrial Accident - Rehoboth Beach

**Rehoboth Beach-** The Delaware State Police are investigating a fatal industrial accident that occurred earlier today.

The incident occurred on March 5, 2020 at approximately 9:56 a.m., when Troopers were dispatched to Colonial Lane, Rehoboth Beach in reference to an industrial accident. Upon arrival, Troopers located an individual pinned beneath a skid steer.

The victim, a 49-year-old male of Millsboro, DE was pronounced deceased at the scene. The victim was turned over to the Delaware Division of Forensic Science where an autopsy will be performed to determine the cause and manner of death. His name is being withheld at this time pending the notification of next of kin.

The case continues to remain under investigation by the Delaware State Police Major Crimes Unit.

# Troopers Investigating Fatal Crash- Harrington

**Harrington**– The Delaware State Police Collision Reconstruction Unit is investigating a fatal crash that occurred last evening.

The crash occurred on March 4, 2020 at approximately 7:35 p.m., when a gray 2014 Buick Regal was traveling eastbound on Vernon Road (SR 14), approaching the intersection of Prospect Church Road. The operator of the Regal was traveling at a high rate of speed and unable to properly negotiate the curve in

the roadway. The operator lost control of the Regal and began to rotate counter-clockwise. A 2014 white Honda Odyssey was traveling westbound on Vernon Road approaching the intersection of Prospect Church Road. The operator of the Odyssey was unable to avoid the approaching, out of control Regal. The Regal struck the Odyssey within the westbound travel lane.

Following the initial impact, the Regal continued in a northeast direction, overturning onto its roof, and ejecting the operator from the vehicle. The Regal continued to slide on its roof before striking a telephone pole and coming to rest.

The operator of the Regal, 37-year-old **Charles E. Garland Jr.**, of Felton, DE was pronounced deceased at the scene.

The operator of the Odyssey, a 36-year-old female from Denton, MD, was properly restrained. She was transported to the Christiana Hospital with serious, non-life threatening injuries. A 7-year-old child was a rear seat passenger who was properly restrained and transported to the A.I. DuPont Children's Hospital with non-life threatening injuries.

The crash continues to remain under investigation by the Delaware State Police Collision Reconstruction Unit.
