

# Troopers Investigating Robbery- New Castle

**New Castle (19720)**- The Delaware State Police are currently investigating an armed robbery that occurred this morning.

On June 29, 2019 at approximately 4:39 a.m., Troopers responded to a local area hospital in reference to a 23-year-old male victim who had been transported by EMS after being assaulted. Further investigation revealed that at approximately 3:44 a.m., the victim was walking in the area of 3000 block of New Castle Avenue, when he was approached by an unknown male and female subject who demanded money. When the victim refused to turn over any money, the male suspect displayed a handgun and the female suspect struck the victim with an unknown object. The suspects obtained an undisclosed amount of cash from the victim's possession prior to fleeing the scene on foot.

The victim was treated at the hospital with non-life threatening injuries.

The suspects were described as a black male and a black female.

## **Troopers Investigating Fatal Crash-South Bethany**

***South Bethany-*** The Delaware State Police Collision Reconstruction Unit is investigating a fatal crash that occurred on June 14, 2019.

Based on investigative analysis, the incident occurred on June 14, 2019 at approximately 12:57 a.m., when a 2011 Mercedes GLK 350, four door sedan, was traveling northbound on York Road approaching Rebecca Road. York Road is a residential roadway

that terminates at a canal access ramp a short distance north of Rebecca Road. A thin cable wire was strung across the entrance to the access ramp. For unknown reasons, after passing Rebecca Road, the Mercedes continued traveling northbound where it entered onto the canal access ramp, struck and ran through the cable wire, and entered into the canal. Once entering into the canal, the Mercedes sank to the bottom and was located on June 29, 2019.

The operator, identified as 70-year-old **Linda Bravo** of Bethany Beach was located on June 28, 2019 and pronounced deceased. She had been listed as a missing person through the Bethany Beach Police Department since her disappearance on June 14, 2019.

The incident occurred within a residential community, and no roadways were closed during the investigation.

The crash continues to remain under investigation by the Delaware State Police Collision Reconstruction Unit.

# **Troopers Investigating Attempted Robbery of 7-11 – Wilmington**

*Wilmington, Delaware (19809)*- Delaware State Police are investigating the attempted robbery of a Wilmington area 7-11 store that occurred late Wednesday night.

The preliminary investigation has determined that the incident occurred on Wednesday, June 26, 2019, at approximately 11:41 p.m., as a male suspect entered the 7-11 located at 4865 Governor Printz Boulevard, Wilmington. The suspect approached the sales counter where he confronted a male clerk and demanded cigarettes. He then displayed an unknown make and model gun and again demanded a carton of cigarettes and the victim again refused to give the cigarettes. After a short

time, the suspect left the store. No merchandise was taken from the store. The suspect fled northbound through the parking lot towards Edgemoor Gardens, out of sight. The clerk was not injured.

The suspect is described as a black male, approximately 20-30 years old, 150-160 lbs, between 5'05"-5'10" with a thin build. Last seen wearing a white t-shirt, dark shorts and dark colored sneakers.

# **Troopers Investigating Convenience Store Robbery- Dover**

## **\*Update 3\* - Barricaded Subject In Custody-Dover**

**Dover-** The Delaware State Police are continuing to investigate the incident in which a subject barricaded himself inside his residence and fired shots at State Troopers.

The incident occurred on June 25, 2019 at approximately 9:12 a.m, when a mother responded to Troop 3 to report that her 38-year-old son, **Justin Topolski** had threatened her with a knife during an argument while inside their residence, located in the unit block of Howe Drive. Members of the Troop 3 Patrol responded to the residence in an attempt to contact Topolski. Upon their arrival, Topolski entered the residence and refused verbal commands to exit. A perimeter was set up around the residence, when Topolski fired shots in the direction of Troopers, subsequently striking a marked DSP Tahoe that was parked in the driveway.

At approximately 12:59 p.m., Topolski exited the residence and was taken into custody without further incident. He was transported to a local area hospital for an evaluation. There were no reports of any injuries as a result of this incident.

This case continues to remain under investigation with charges forthcoming.
