Millsboro Man Charged with Vehicular Assault after Crash

Millsboro – Delaware State Troopers have charged a Millsboro man with two counts of vehicular assault after he was involved in a crash and found to be driving under the influence.

The incident occurred on Friday, September 28, 2018 at approximately 3:00 a.m., when Troopers were dispatched to the area of Millsboro Highway and Godwin School Road for a report of a crash. Upon arrival, it was determined that a 2016 BMW was headed eastbound on Millsboro Highway when it failed to maintain its lane. The BMW entered into the westbound lane of travel and struck a 2009 Blue Nissan Altima head on.

Upon contact with the operator of the BMW, 31-year-old **Lamar Finney**, an odor of alcohol was detected and a DUI investigation ensued.

The operator of the Altima, a 24-year-old male from Laurel was transported to the Beebe Medical Center with serious injuries. A passenger in the Altima, an 18-year-old female from Millsboro, was also transported to the Beebe Medical Center with serious injuries.

Finney was transported back to Troop 4 where he was charged with the following:

- Vehicular Assault First Degree (2 counts)
- Driving a Vehicle Under the Influence of Alcohol
- Failure to Transfer Title and Registration
- Failure to remain within a single lane

Finney was arraigned before the Justice of the Peace Court 3 and released on \$7,002.00 unsecured bond.

Troopers Investigating Robbery – Pike Creek



Newark (19711) – The Delaware State Police are investigating a robbery that took place in the parking lot of the Polly Drummond Shopping Center on Wednesday night.

The incident occurred at approximately 8:59 p.m., Wednesday, September 26, 2018 in the parking lot, outside of Samson's

Country Maid Deli, located at 14 Polly Drummond Shopping Center, Newark. An employee of the business had just returned to his vehicle which was parked in the lot, after closing the business for the night. As he sat in his vehicle, prior to driving off, he was approached by two suspects. The first suspect grabbed the victim as he sat in the drivers seat and demanded money, while the second suspect entered the vehicle through the passenger side front door. Once inside the vehicle Suspect #2 rifled through multiple bags that were on the front seat taking one of them. Suspect #1 made off with the victim's wallet, cell-phone and car keys. Both suspects then entered in to a light colored vehicle and fled onto Linden Hill Rd. The victim was not injured as a result of the incident.

The suspects were described as follows:

Suspect #1: Black male, 25-35 years of age, thin build, wearing all dark clothing to include a face covering.

Suspect #2: Black male, 25-35 years of age, thin build, wearing all white clothing and a dark covering over his face.

No surveillance images are available at this time.

***Update* Georgetown Man Arraigned and New Bond Set**

Georgetown- An emergency bond hearing sets a new bail amount for 22-year-old Clay Conaway who was charged with Rape in the first degree and six counts of Rape in the second degree.

On Thursday, September 27, 2018, Clay Conaway had an emergency bond hearing where he was arraigned on the six additional counts of Rape in the Second Degree. Conaway received an additional \$240,000.00 secured bond on top of the original \$70,000.00 secured bond and was committed to the Sussex Correctional Institution and ordered to have no contact with the victims or their families.

Assault Leads to Burglary and Weapon Charges-Delmar

Delmar- The Delaware State Police have arrested a Salisbury, Maryland man after he entered into a residence uninvited and assaulted a resident.

The incident occurred on Tuesday, September 4, 2018 at approximately 10:50 a.m., when Troopers were dispatched to the 12000 block of Line Road for a report of an assault. Prior to the Troopers arrival, it was learned that a 65-year-old male victim was in the process of being transported to the Peninsula Regional Medical Center. Contact was made with the victim at the hospital where he indicated that an acquaintance, 66-year-old **William D. Betts** had entered his residence unannounced and began arguing and threatening to kill him. Betts soon after left the residence and entered the victim's detached garage where he began pushing items over. Betts obtained a crowbar and a screwdriver and proceeded back into the residence. He continued to confront the victim, striking him over the head with the crowbar and threatening him with the screwdriver, prior to leaving the scene.

The victim was treated and released from the hospital with non-life threatening injuries.

On Wednesday, September 26, 2018, Betts turned himself in at Troop 5 where he was charged with the following:

- Possession of a Deadly Weapon During the Commission of a Felony (2 counts)
- Burglary Second Degree
- Aggravated Menacing (2 counts)
- Burglary Third Degree

- Assault Third Degree

- Criminal Mischief

Betts was arraigned before the Justice of the Peace Court 2 and released on \$58,100.00 unsecured bond.

Troopers Investigating Shots Fired Incident-Magnolia

Magnolia– The Delaware State Police are currently investigating a shots fired complaint in which a residence was struck.
