

State Police Arrest Chester Man Following Series of Burglaries at Claymont Nonprofit

The Delaware State Police arrested 22-year-old **Ammar Dixon**, from Chester, Pennsylvania, on burglary, theft, and unauthorized use of a motor vehicle charges following several burglaries to a not-for-profit business that occurred mid-March in Claymont.

On March 17, 2026, troopers responded to Conexio Care, located at 590 Naamans Road, for a report of multiple burglaries. The preliminary investigation revealed that between March 13, 2026, and March 17, 2026, an unknown suspect, later identified as Ammar Dixon, unlawfully entered the business multiple times during the overnight hours. The Delaware State Police Criminal Investigations Unit took over the case.

Investigators determined that during the first incident, Dixon, who had no affiliation with the business, was confronted by an employee who was still inside the building. Dixon fled the scene after stealing an access badge. Employees later discovered Dixon had left behind a bag containing items with his personal identifiable information.

Detectives learned that over the following nights, Dixon used the stolen access badge to enter the building multiple times, rummage through offices, and steal keys to vehicles belonging to the business. Dixon then drove several of the vehicles before returning them to the parking garage. Detectives obtained a warrant for Dixon's arrest.

On April 12, 2026, Dixon was arrested in Pennsylvania for an unrelated incident and, on May 5, 2026, he was extradited to

Delaware. Dixon was taken to Troop 2 where he was charged with the below listed offenses, arraigned by Justice of the Peace Court 2, and released on a \$19,000 unsecured bond.



- Burglary Third Degree (Felony) – 4 counts
- Theft Under \$1500 – 3 counts
- Attempted to Commit Theft Under \$1500
- Unauthorized Use of a Vehicle Without the Consent of the Owner – 3 counts

State Police Investigating Fatal Motorcycle Crash on River Road in Seaford

The Delaware State Police are investigating a fatal motorcycle crash that occurred Saturday night in Seaford.

On May 9, 2026, at approximately 9:20 p.m., a Yamaha XVS motorcycle was traveling westbound on River Road east of Woodland Ferry Road at an apparent high rate of speed. The preliminary investigation revealed that the motorcycle failed to negotiate a curve, fell on its side, and skidded off the roadway.

The rider, a 56-year-old man from Seaford, Delaware, was taken to an area hospital with life-threatening injuries. On May 10,

2026, he died because of his injuries. His name is being withheld until his family is notified.

State Police Investigating a Fatal Crash on Sandtown Road in Felton

The Delaware State Police are investigating a fatal crash that occurred on Sunday in Felton.

On May 10, 2026, at approximately 4:50 p.m., a Kia Sorento was traveling northbound on Sandtown Road south of Willow Grove Road in Felton. The preliminary investigation revealed that the Sorento was traveling at an apparent high rate of speed,

passed two vehicles in a no passing zone, then failed to negotiate a curve. As a result, the Sorento exited the west edge of the road and struck two unoccupied commercial trucks and trailers in a parking lot.

The driver, an 80-year-old man from Goldsboro, Maryland, was not properly restrained and taken to an area hospital where he died. His name is being withheld until his family is notified.

The roadway was closed for approximately 3 hours while the scene was investigated and cleared.

State Police Investigating Shooting in Laurel

The Delaware State Police are investigating a shooting that occurred Saturday afternoon in Laurel.

On May 9, 2026, at approximately 3:20 p.m., troopers responded to Tidal Health – Nanticoke after a 19-year-old man arrived, by personal vehicle, with non-life-threatening gunshot wounds. Due to the nature of the incident, Delaware State Police Troop 4 Criminal Investigations Unit assumed the investigation. The preliminary investigation revealed that the victim was shot in front of a residence by an unknown suspect on Portsville Road near Randall Street in Laurel.

Further investigation revealed that the victim was driven to the hospital in a blue Mazda 3 by a man identified as 20-year-old **Alexison Amisial**, from Georgetown, Delaware. Troopers found the Mazda and Amisial at First Stop Gas Station, located at 114 West Street in Laurel. When troopers contacted Amisial, he was found to be concealing an untraceable gun in his waistband and was taken into custody without incident.

Amisial was arrested and taken to Troop 4, where he was charged with the crimes listed below, arraigned by Justice of the Peace Court 3, and released on a \$3,500 unsecured bond.



- Carrying a Concealed Deadly Weapon – Firearm (Felony)
- Possession of an Untraceable Firearm (Felony)

Suspect in Custody Following Barricade Incident and Fire

at Wawa on Limestone Road in Wilmington

The Delaware State Police and the Delaware State Fire Marshal's Office have taken 36-year-old **Raul Zavala**, of Wilmington, Delaware, into custody after he barricaded himself and set a fire at a Wawa in Wilmington on Saturday night.

On May 9, 2026, at approximately 8:20 p.m., troopers responded to Wawa, located at 2030 Limestone Road in Wilmington, for a report of terroristic threatening. When troopers arrived, they encountered Raul Zavala, who barricaded himself and two co-workers, in the manager's office. Zavala refused commands to exit and ultimately set fire to the electrical closet inside the office, which quickly spread. As a result of the fire, Zavala was forced to exit the office where he was taken into custody following a taser deployment.

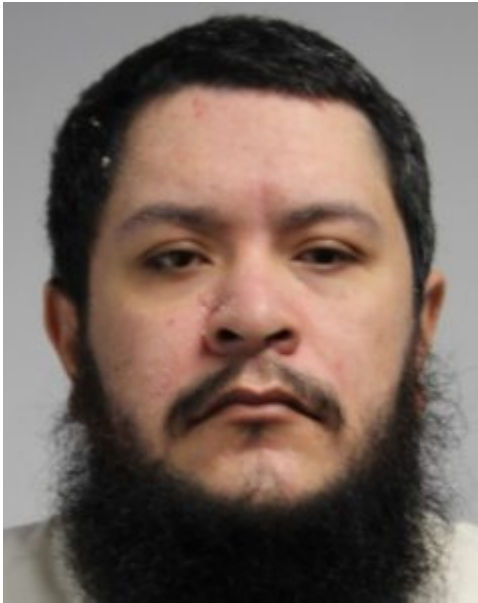
One of the co-workers, a 21-year-old man from Wilmington, Delaware, was taken to an area hospital with minor injuries.

The second co-worker, a 50-year-old woman also from Wilmington, Delaware, was uninjured.

The Delaware State Police Troop 2 Criminal Investigations Unit assumed the investigation. Detectives learned that prior to the arrival of troopers, the male co-worker entered the office to speak with Zavala about an incident earlier in the night.

Zavala initially slammed the door on the co-worker but then let him inside and upon entering Zavala assaulted the co-worker and threatened further harm if he left the room. The female co-worker was alerted to the incident and responded to the office. Once inside, Zavala brandished a knife, threatening both of them and refused to allow them to leave the room. When troopers attempted to enter the office, Zavala ran into the electrical closet, locked the door, and the two co-workers escaped.

Zavala was taken to an area hospital for burn injuries. Once released from the hospital, he will be charged with the crimes listed below.



- Possession of a Deadly Weapon During the Commission of a Felony (Felony)
- Aggravated Menacing (Felony) – 2 counts
- Unlawful Imprisonment (Felony) – 2 counts
- Arson 2nd Degree (Felony)
- Criminal Mischief – \$5,000 or More (Felony)
- Assault 3rd Degree

State Police Arrest Former Police Officer for Rape

The Delaware State Police have arrested 33-year-old **William Paskey** of Harrington, Delaware, a former Delaware and Maryland police officer, for rape following a sexual assault investigation.

In May 2025, the Delaware State Police Troop 3 Criminal Investigations Unit began investigating a sexual assault allegation against William Paskey. Detectives learned that in September 2022, Paskey met the female victim on a dating app and invited her to his residence in Harrington. The victim reported that during the date, Paskey became aggressive and engaged in nonconsensual sexual acts with her, refusing her multiple requests to stop. Paskey was employed as a law enforcement officer at the time of the incident, but was not on duty.

After consulting with the Delaware Department of Justice, a

warrant for Paskey's arrest was obtained, and he was taken into custody on May 5, 2026, without incident. Paskey was taken to Troop 3, where he was charged with Rape Second Degree (Felony), arraigned by the Justice of the Peace Court 2, and released after posting a \$20,000 secured bond.

Paskey is a former Delaware police officer who, between 2014 and 2021, was employed by various departments, including the Dagsboro, Ellendale, and Blades Police Departments. Most recently, Paskey was employed as a police officer for the Town of Ridgely Police Department in Maryland.

State Police Arrest Dover Teen for Threatening Smyrna

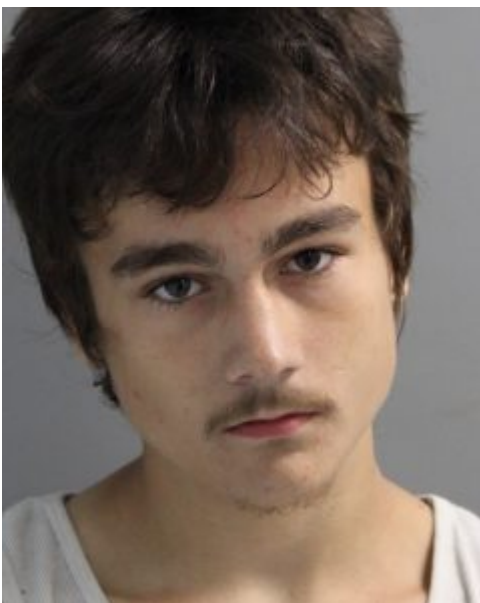
Residents with Knife

The Delaware State Police arrested 18-year-old **Aaron Jernigan**, of Dover, Delaware, on felony aggravated menacing and related charges after using a knife to threaten residents in a Smyrna community in mid-April.

On April 18, 2026, at approximately 6:30 p.m., troopers responded to the Holly Hill Estates community in Smyrna for a report of a disorderly man threatening residents. The preliminary investigation revealed that an unknown male suspect engaged in a loud verbal dispute with several community members before brandishing a pocketknife and threatening to harm them. The suspect fled the area before troopers arrived.

Through continued investigative efforts, troopers identified the suspect as Jernigan and obtained a warrant for his arrest.

On May 5, 2026, Jernigan was located and arrested in Dover. He was taken to Troop 9 where he was charged with the below listed offenses, arraigned by Justice of the Peace Court 11, and committed to the Howard R. Young Correctional Institution on a \$16,100 secured bond.
