Delaware State Police Detectives are investigating a shooting that occurred last night in Lincoln.

On March 9, 2025, at approximately 9:25 p.m., troopers responded to the area of Cabbage Drive and Cedar Drive in Lincoln for a report of shooting. When troopers arrived, they found a 24-year-old man suffering from a gunshot wound. He was taken to an area hospital with non-life-threatening injuries. The investigation is active and ongoing.

# Troopers Investigating Road Rage Incident on I-95

Delaware State Police are investigating a road rage incident involving a gun that occurred yesterday on I-95 in Wilmington.

On March 7, 2025, at approximately 12:50 p.m., troopers responded to the 900 block of Concord Avenue in Wilmington, for a report of a road rage incident involving a gun that occurred on I-95. The preliminary investigation revealed that a 48-year-old male victim, was traveling on the 141 ramp for I-95 northbound. At the same time, a U-Haul box truck, driven by an unknown black male suspect, was tailgating the victim. The victim applied the brakes, and the suspect slowed, then pulled next to the victim. The two were engaged in an argument when the suspect pointed a gun at him and sped away. The victim was not hurt.

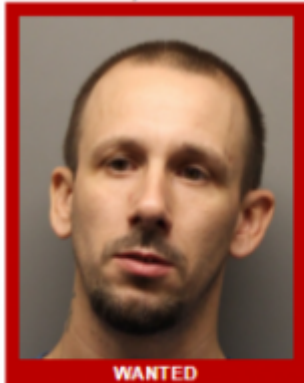

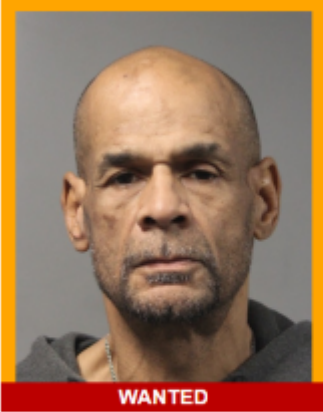

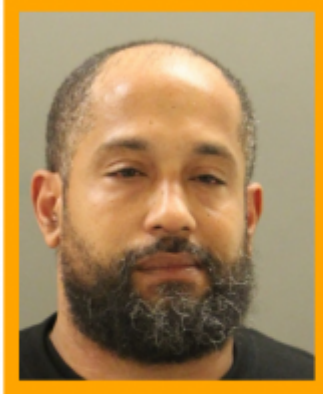

# State Police Arrest Pennsylvania Man for Assault Following Crash in Milford

Delaware State Police arrested 45-year-old **Jason Boyd** of Lincoln University, Pennsylvania, for felony assault after he pepper-sprayed a man following a motor vehicle crash yesterday afternoon.

On March 4, 2025, at approximately 1:00 p.m., troopers responded to 793 Bay Road in Milford for a reported crash. A preliminary investigation revealed that a 50-year-old man from Milford, Delaware, was driving southbound on Bay Road near Jenkins Pond Road in a Honda Element. Boyd, driving a Chevrolet Silverado, was following behind the Honda when he allegedly began tailgating. In response, the 50-year-old driver abruptly applied his brakes, causing Boyd's vehicle to crash into the rear of the Honda.

Both drivers then pulled into the parking lot of I.G. Burton to assess the damage. As the 50-year-old man exited his vehicle and approached the Chevrolet, Boyd allegedly pepper-sprayed him before troopers arrived. Emergency Medical Services responded and treated the 50-year-old man for minor injuries.

Troopers contacted Boyd and observed a canister of pepper spray inside his truck. They also discovered that his vehicle registration was expired. Boyd was taken into custody without incident and transported to Troop 3, where he was charged with:

victim complied and the suspect fled on foot with an undisclosed amount of cash. Troopers attempted to locate the suspect in the surrounding area but were unable to find him.

Through investigative means, Troop 2 Robbery Detectives identified Gregory Davis as the suspect responsible for the robbery, and obtained a warrant for his arrest for multiple felony charges. Detectives are seeking the public's assistance in their on-going efforts to locate Davis, whose current whereabouts are unknown.

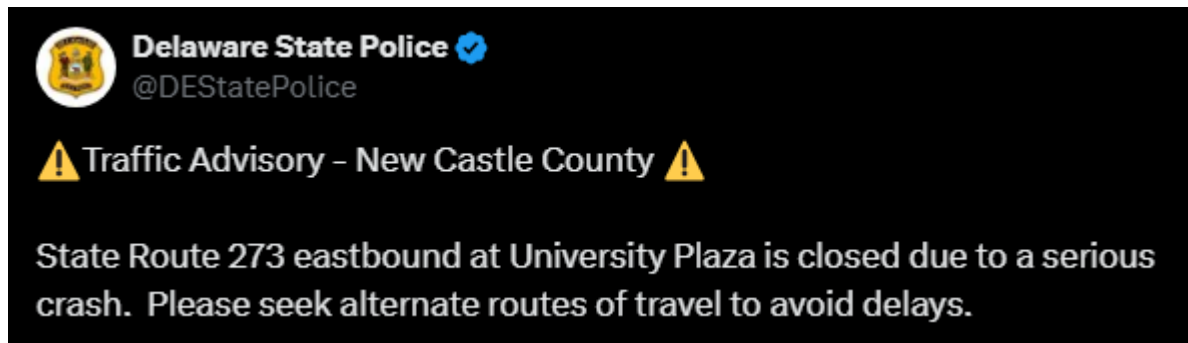

# State Police Investigating Fatal Two-Vehicle Crash in Newark

The Delaware State Police are investigating a fatal two-vehicle crash that occurred this morning in Newark that left one man dead.

On March 4, 2025, at approximately 6:19 a.m., a 2013 Honda CR-V was stopped in the left turn lane on Christiana Road westbound, west of Browns Lane, attempting to turn left into University Plaza. At the same time, a 2018 Honda Pilot was traveling in the right lane of Christiana Road eastbound, east of Chapman Road. For reasons under investigation, the CR-V proceeded to turn left and entered directly into the Pilot's path of travel. As a result, the front of the Pilot collided with the right side of the CR-V in the eastbound lanes of Christiana Road.

The driver of the CR-V, an 84-year-old man from Newark, Delaware, was transported to an area hospital, where he was later pronounced dead. His name is being withheld until his family and relatives are notified.

The driver of the Pilot, a 46-year-old woman from Elkton, Maryland, was taken to an area hospital for non-life-threatening injuries. The Pilot's passengers, a 15-year-old female and an 8-year-old female, were also taken to an area hospital for non-life-threatening injuries.

The roadway was closed for approximately 3 hours while the scene was investigated and cleared the roadway.

## Detectives Investigating Road Rage Related Shots Fired Incident in New Castle

The Delaware State Police are investigating a road rage related shots fired incident that occurred Sunday morning in

New Castle.

On March 2, 2025, at approximately 9:41 a.m., troopers responded to North Dupont Highway, in the area of Fairview Avenue, New Castle, for a report of shots fired stemming from a road rage incident. The preliminary investigation revealed a BMW SUV was involved in a road rage incident with an unknown sedan. During the incident, the suspect, who was in the front passenger seat, discharged a firearm at the victim. The BMW, and its driver, a 35-year-old Delaware man, were not struck by gunfire. Following the shots fired, the suspect vehicle fled southbound on North Dupont Highway.

The suspect is described as a masked black male wearing dark-colored clothing. There is no additional suspect or suspect vehicle information available at this time.
