

Troop 1 – Representative Krista Griffith

Krista Griffith is State Representative for the 12th District of Delaware, which includes neighborhoods in Hockessin, Greenville and North Wilmington.

Prior to being elected in November 2018, Krista served for nearly a decade as a Deputy Attorney General in the Delaware Department of Justice under the administrations of Beau Biden and Matt Denn. Krista led Attorney General Biden's Senior Protection Initiative and was assistant unit head of the Department of Justice's Domestic Violence and Child Abuse units. Krista also represented state agencies including the Department of Services for Children, Youth and their Families. Krista began her career in Delaware clerking for the Hon. James T. Vaughn, Jr., Justice of the Supreme Court of Delaware, who then served as President Judge of the Superior Court.

Krista left the Department of Justice in 2015 when her younger son, Nate, faced a life-threatening leukemia diagnosis. She spent months at Nate's bedside while he underwent successful cancer treatment. Since her son's recovery Krista has dedicated hundreds of hours to board

leadership and community service for several nonprofit organizations including the Down Syndrome Association of Delaware.

Currently Krista serves on the following House committees: Telecommunications, Internet & Technology (chair); Judiciary (vice chair); Natural Resources (vice chair); Economic Development, Banking & Insurance; Energy; and Veterans Affairs. Additionally, she serves on the Domestic Violence Coordinating Council, a state agency created to improve Delaware's response to domestic violence and sexual assault.

Krista and her husband, Ted, live in Fairfax with their boys, Sam and Nate.
